for construction of watermain including appurtenances, service connections and road reconstruction in the communities of Ballantrae and Musselman Lake.

Estimated quantities for major items are as follows:

- 20,336 metres of watermain (sizes 150 mm to 300 mm dia.)
- 159 hydrants
- 69 valves (sizes 150 mm to 300 mm)
- Road reconstruction 6.4 km

The work will be divided into Part A (Ballantrae) and Part B (Musselman Lake). Tenderers may bid on either of both parts.
