## Water system construction begins

Residents living along the route of the Ballantrae-Musselman communal water system will soon get an information letter letting them know how construction is expected to affect them.

Tom Perry, Whitchurch-Stouffville's engineer, said the multi-million dollar project should get under way by the end of February.

The contract was awarded to Clearway Construction Inc.

In the next day or two, Perry plans to sit down with officials from Clearway and go over the contractors' preferred route. However, Perry said the construction will begin at two points. One will be at McCowan Road and Aurora Sideroad, he said.

Two weeks ago, Whitchurch-Stouffville council accepted the lowest tender of \$4.6 million for such items as water mains, hydrants and service connections after receiving bids from 42 construction contractors.

York Region will cover the cost of the well and the water tower, while 847 individual property owners will pay for hookup.
