### SUBJECT PROPERTY

The lands affected by the proposed By-law Amendments are as follows:  
•9401 Highway 48 (east side of Highway 48, north of 16th Avenue-O.Reg. 145/72)  
•9704 McCowan Road (east side of McCowan Road, south of Major MacKenzie Drive O.Reg. 692/77)  
•6329 Major MacKenzie Drive (south side of Major MacKenzie Drive, east of the railway-O.Reg. 137/79)  
•9927 & 9929 Kennedy Road (south-east corner of Major MacKenzie Drive and Kennedy Road-O.Reg. 722/79)

### BACKGROUND

The town has requested the Province to lift the Minister's Airport Zoning Order (Ontario Regulation 104/72) from our Future Urban Area as identified in OPA No. 5. The Town's underlying zoning by-laws have not been updated while the Minister's Zoning Order has been in place, and now, in several instances, do not reflect the uses and/or development standards approved for certain lands by way of amendments to the Order over the years. The Town is therefore bringing forward amendments to the Town's zoning by-laws for the four properties noted above, to incorporate land uses and development standards previously approved as amendments to the Minister's Zoning Order.

### PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

To amend Markham Zoning By-laws 304-87 and 88-76, as amended, to incorporate into these by-laws the provisions of previously approved amendments to the Minister's Airport Zoning Order. This will update the Town's Zoning to reflect the status quo under the Minister's Zoning order, and will ensure that the previously approved amendments are recognized following revocation of the Order.
