

# Mobility Transit golf tourney slated for May 28

**MOBILITY TRANSIT GOLF TOURNAMENT**  
The second annual fund-raising golf tournament for Whitchurch-Stouffville Mobility Transit, sponsored by Digital Processing Systems Inc.

and Algonquin Brewing Co. will take place Tuesday, May 28, at the Thunderbird Golf Club in Ashburn. The entry fee of \$150 includes a day of golf, power carts, lunch, two beer tickets

and dinner, as well as the opportunity to win some great prizes. The number of golfers has been limited to 144 and many of last year's competitors have already signed up, so

early registration is recommended. Groups of four players can sponsor a hole for \$100 and non-players can sponsor a hole for \$200. Sponsors will be recognized by signs on the course and in



a listing in the program at dinner and donations of prizes are also welcome.

Tax receipts will be available for both golfers and sponsors supporting the event.

Volunteers will provide respite care to enable people to attend the meetings.

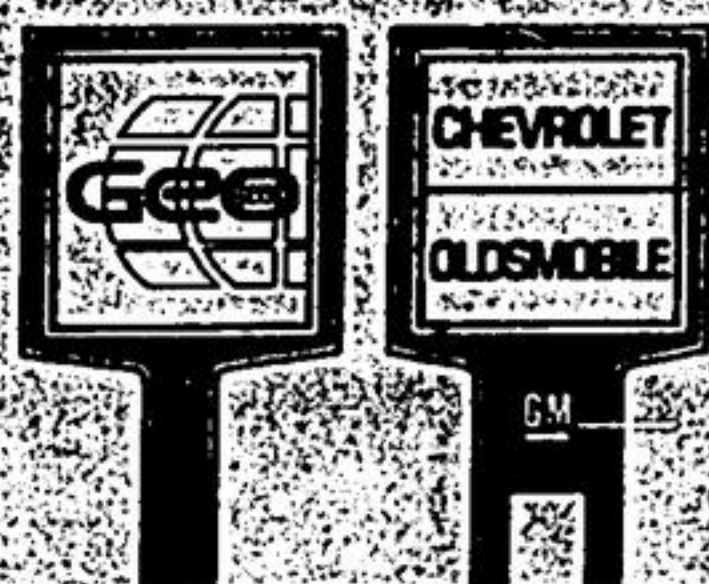
