## Teacher union prefers local bargaining

Local bargaining works for school boards, Catholic teachers from York Region have told a provincial review.

The practice is key to settling a contract with area teachers because it can consider unique conditions in the region like rapid growth and higher living expenses, president of York Catholic Teachers Ihor Baczynsky and vice-president Claire Laughlin argued at a recent hearing.

In August, Ontario's Education Minister John Snobelen ordered a review of the School Board and Teacher Collective Negotiations Act, or Bill 100, which covers board negotiations, saying the system is "not working."

Snobelen has suggested bargaining may no longer be done locally and that teachers may lose the right to strike.

But in more than 21 years, York Region separate school teachers have chosen a strike action only twice — and both were work-to-rule campaigns, the delegation said. "No student has lost a day of their education," said the teachers, adding such a result is typical. "The obvious conclusion is that there is not a problem here."

## Musical students take stage Friday

The fourth annual Student Music Scholarship Concert, sponsored by St. James Presbyterian Church, takes place at Stouffville District Secondary School on Friday, Oct. 18 at 7 p.m.

The evening will also feature vocal solos by April Yakeley and Clara Jordan, performances by Adam and Laura Rochacewich, playing piano and violin respectively, and flute music by Julie Hazlewood.

A pre-concert piano recital by Melissa McElroy will welcome the audience for a fine evening of beautiful music, and donations for a free-will collection will be divided among the participating schools for their music programs.

Whitchurch-Stouffville trustee Harry Bowes will represent the York Region Board of Education at the concert, which last year attracted close to 800 people.
