EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT CHARGE PROPOSALS

TAKE NOTICE that on November 20, 1996, The York Region Roman Catholic Separate School Board and The York Region Board of Education will hold public meetings together pursuant to Section 31 and 33(5) of the Development Charges Act, to consider proposed new education development charges in York Region.

The purpose of the joint meeting is to ensure that sufficient information is made available to enable the public to understand generally the education development charge proposals and to solicit public input. Any person who attends the joint meeting may make a representation to the Boards in respect of the proposed education development charges.

All interested persons are invited to attend.

Written submissions which are received at least one week prior to the joint public meeting will be distributed to all trustees prior to the meeting. All written submissions will be available for public viewing during business hours at the Education Centre of The York Region Board of Education at 60 Wellington Street West, Aurora L4G 3H2 and for The York Region Roman Catholic Separate School Board at 320 Bloomington Road West, Aurora, Ontario L4G 3G8. All submissions received in writing prior to November 15, 1996 and those expressed at the joint public meeting will be considered prior to the enactment of a new by-law.

In order to provide background to the proposed by-law and to ensure sufficient information is available at and prior to the joint meeting, copies of the report which received Ministry of Education and Training approval, along with other background information, will be available at 320 Bloomington Road West, Aurora, after October 14, 1996 during regular business hours.

The Boards will each meet to give consideration to passage of new education development charge by-laws on November 20, 1996 following the public meeting.
