Public hearing quashed

The move to have a public hearing on the new town hall-library-art gallery complex is dead despite a last minute attempt by a resident to keep it alive.

On Tuesday, Stouffville resident Sue Sherban presented Whitchurch-Stouffville council with a 31-name petition calling for a public meeting to deal with the \$2.5 million project, slated for the Main Street-Duffin's Creek area taking in the library.

Sherban told *The Tribune* she was both surprised and disappointed that council rejected having such a "high ticket" item scrutinized by the public.

While Ward 1 councillor Ivanka Bradley pushed for the public hearing, the only support came from Ward 6 councillor Mark Kostandoff.

Council has agreed, in principle, to build the complex, while staff is expected to outline more details very soon.

Sherban suggested that all high-priced capital projects be reviewed by the public.

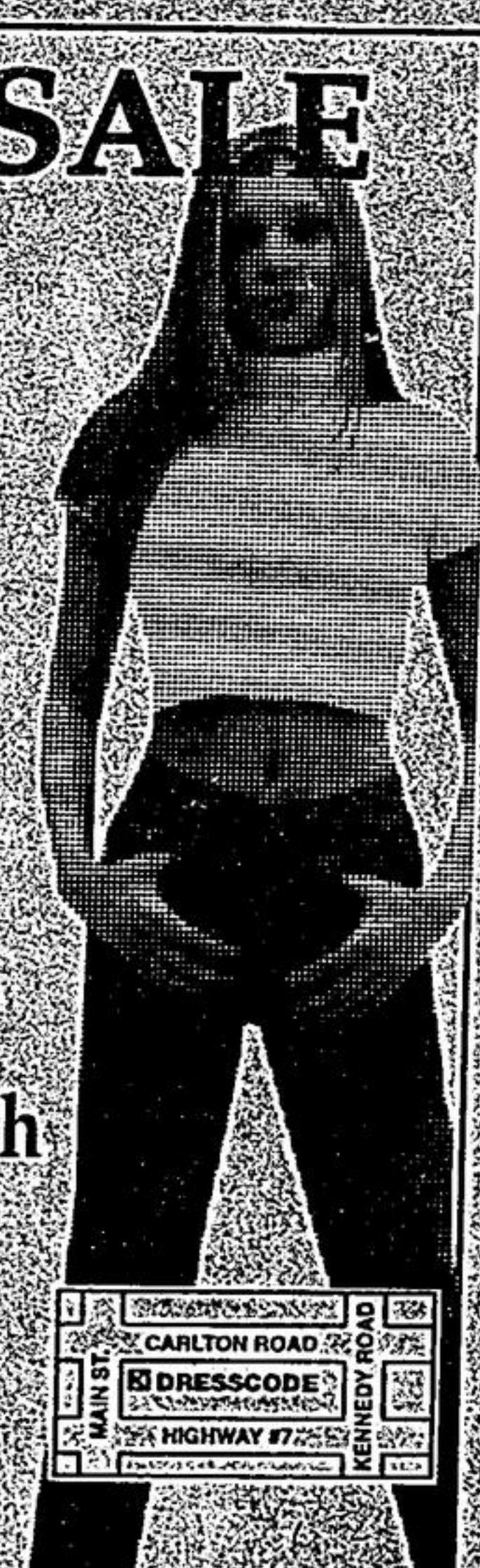
