

Town sells land for fire hall fund

A small parcel of town-owned land has been sold for \$250,000.

The money from the land, located on Hwy. 48 and Aurora Road, has been earmarked for the future fire station in Ballantrae.

The land is less than an acre in size. It was included in this year's surplus land list. Whitchurch-Stouffville council approved the sale at a regular council meeting Tuesday.

The town expects to

receive a re-zoning application asking that the land presently zoned residential be switched to local commercial to accommodate a retail take-out outlet or a service station.

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NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Amendment to Development Charges By-law
No. DC 2-94-119

On December 12, 1996, the Council of the Regional Municipality of York will hold a public meeting pursuant to Section 4(1) and Section 77 of the Development Charges Act. The purpose of the meeting is to inform the public of a proposed amendment to Regional Development Charges By-law No. DC 2-94-119.

The amendment to the Regional Development Charges By-law will reflect the following proposed policy revision:

The current non-residential development charge rate will not be subject to a scheduled phased increase effective November 24, 1996. Any phasing of the non-residential development charge rate will be deferred until consideration of a revised Development Charge By-law.

The effect of the proposed amendment would be to maintain the non-residential development charge rate at \$1.29 per square foot for development on full services. Development Charge By-law No. DC 2-94-119 had a scheduled increase to \$1.80 per non-residential square foot effective November 24, 1996, and Regional Council has chosen to maintain the development charge rate at existing levels as an incentive to non-residential development.
