## Year in review

Bogus bills were found circulating in Stouffville as area businesses were victimized by phony \$10 and \$20 bills

The town hall mailbox was the target of the two heists in three weeks, with the thieves using stolen cheques as a means of accessing bank accounts of several victims

A local man was denied bail after being charged with attempted murder and cultivation and possession of marijuana after \$5,000 worth of the plant was discovered growing on his 90 acre farm

Town staff considered bids from 30 companies for the contract to build the proposed two to three million dollar town hall/library expansion in downtown Stouffville

More than 60 counsellors at Gormley kids summer camp were left empty handed when cheques for their entire summer's work bounced when the camp folded. A group of anonymous donors surfaced to honor the cheques several weeks later

A 23-year-old Downsview resident was charged with impaired driving causing death when a car crash at Musselman Lake killed area teen Darlene Oblenes

### SEPTEMBER

A home made pipe bomb was found underneath a portable at Summitview Public School as caretakers prepared the school for the upcoming school year

Beleaguered independent Markham/Whitchurch-Stouffville MP Jag Bhaduria claimed success after leading a consortium of Canadian companies to Iraq on a trade mission. The MP told Canada and the United States to stay out of Iraq's internal affairs

A swimming pool that was to have been

part of a multi-million dollar seniors apartment complex in downtown Stouffville was scrapped. Mayor Wayne Emmerson said council would consider a plan to have a pool built at either Stouffville District High School or in front of the Ninth Line Recreation Complex

Construction of Stouffville's \$1.1 million second ice pad got underway as local contractor The Branick Group gave a January 1997 target date for completion

Amid a heated debate with council, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Library Board announced it wanted no part of a plan to combine a new town hall with a library expansion. Council's Library Board representative Margot Marshall resigned from the board amid the furor, which included suggestions that the Latham Gallery may choose to operate independent of the town

A 10-member committee was established to hold public meetings to help shape the growth management and Secondary Plan, a \$300,000 blue print designed to take the town well into the next century

MP Jag Bhaduria announced he is suing his former Toronto Board of Education employees for \$96.5 million for firing him after he wrote the board two threatening letters in 1990

Council approved plans for a day care centre to be located at the 10th Line site which formerly housed the Deer Park Inn and Ricci's East Restaurant

Giant vegetable grower Norm Craven won a 1996 Cavalier automobile in the CHIN Radio/Dean Meyers Chev-Olds Great Zucchini Contest

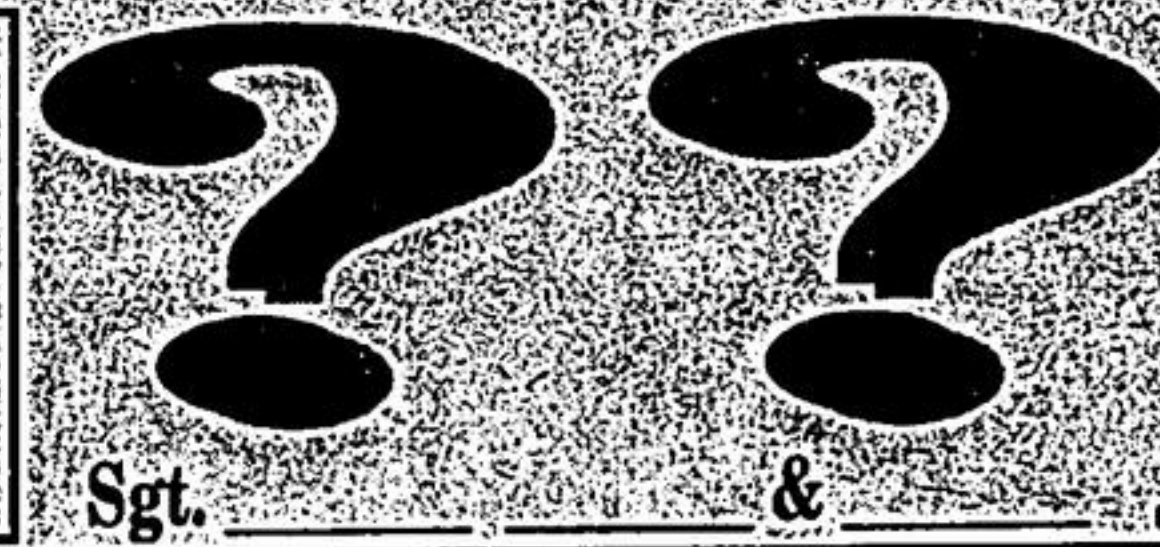
