

Mennonite congregation holds inaugural service Sunday

SKYLAB FLIES HIGH

Summitview Public School's state-of-the-art computer laboratory, Skylab, is a joint project involving the school community, the York Region Board of Education and the Parent Council (formerly the Parent Association).

"It's been a two-year project to this point, utilizing the board's program of matching locally raised funds," explained vice principal Claude Zorzi.

In the past two years, \$17,000 has been raised, both in the school and through the Parent Council, and this amount has been matched by the board.

"We have 18 Icons (computers) that are connected to a file server and 19 multi-

media CD-ROM computers and one that is being hooked up to the Internet," Zorzi said.

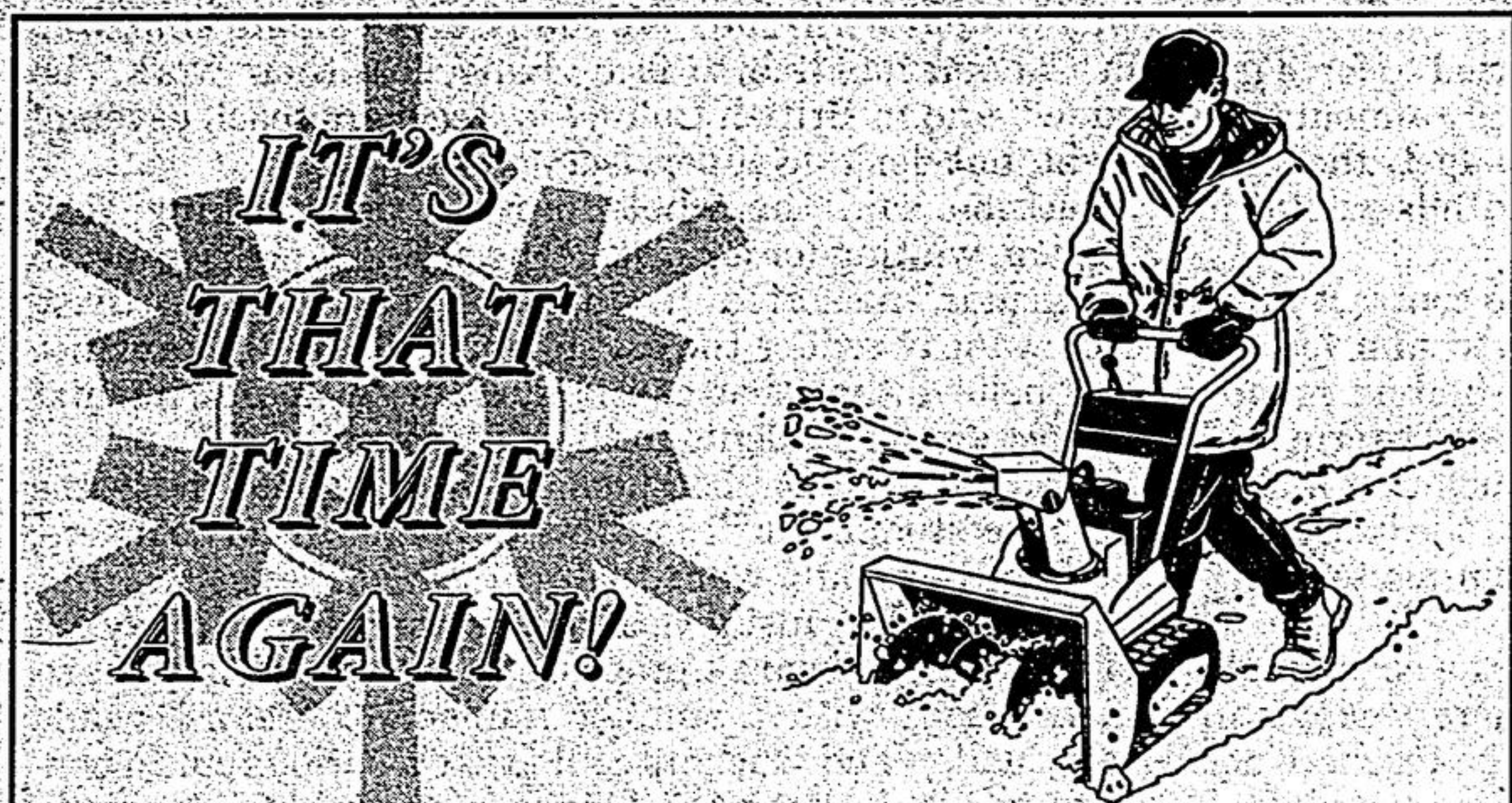
The latter is not located in Skylab, but a second Internet hookup is planned for the computer room. "We're working on some trial mechanisms for controlling access (to the Internet) with a consultant from the board and these have not yet been finalized."

Each class will have access to the laboratory at least once a week and four teachers have been designated to set up and run programs in line with the board curriculum.

The Skylab will enable students to work on keyboarding skills at all levels and will provide access to a wide variety of interactive learning programs, CD-ROM materials and the Internet.
