Movie company officials say town too small for theatre

Stouffville is too small to accommodate a movie theatre, officials from theatre companies have told *The Tribune*.

While Whitchurch-Stouffville Mayor Wayne Emmerson said he will try to woo a movie company to town, Roger Harris, vice president of marketing for Famous Players Inc., said the types of theatre screens his company is involved in need the support of communities with population of about 100,000.

"A town of 30,000 would not support a theatre of our type" said Harris.

Still, the Famous Players executive said he'll welcome an inquiry from Emmerson.

"I'd be more than happy to hear from him," said Harris.

A Cineplex Odeon company executive said Stouffville is "far too small" to be considered on her company's location map.

"We need half a million people" said Marcy Davies, vice president of marketing.

Cineplex Odeon has 300 movie theatres across North America. One is underway in Markham.

But Emmerson said he is not going to take no for an answer. Stouffville can support a theatre, he said.

"I think we're large enough now," said Emmerson.

He added, "It know it won't happen over night, but let's get in on the ground floor."

Emmerson's plan is to contract both Famous Player and Cineplex Odeon within a month.

complex on the Ninth Line or near Stouffville District Secondary School by 1998.

"We're going to get down to business on the pool," said Emmerson.

Meanwhile, construction of the town's second ice pad is on schedule. It will open in February, said Emmerson.
