 Town administrator Merlin Dewing views the change as a positive move. "It's under council control. Council is the one putting up the money so it seems only fair," said Dewing. Losing provincial funding

doesn't worry Dewing. "I anticipate that all our transfer payments will go to zero. This might cause a bit of a hardship but it's not as if this came out of the blue," said Dewing.  
 Citizenship and Culture Minister Marilyn Mushinski has stated

that the new approach will "improve the delivery of library services and lower costs of service because local officials know what is best for their communities"

Hoist that haggis - Robbie Burns night is fast approaching.  
 Both the Town Crier and the Earl of Whitchurch will be featuring special events on Jan. 25 to the celebrate the venerable Scottish poet's birth.  
 At the Earl of Whitchurch, the haggis will be piped in by Bruce Ganby, and Whitchurch-Stouffville librarian Sheila McLeod will perform her inimitable address to this wondrous concoction at 7.30 p.m. before leaving to undertake the same task at the Heritage Arms, the Earl's sister pub in Markham.

In addition to haggis, special menu items include Scottish pies, bashed neeps and mashed tatties, said owner Graham Hoad. "Last year was extremely busy - we were sending people up from Markham because it was full there and we could hardly accommodate them here."  
 Reservations are strongly recommended.

The perennially popular Syd Simpkins will be on hand to provide his special brand of entertainment at the Town Crier, where patrons can enjoy an authentic Scottish meal and the traditional address to the haggis, which will be officially welcomed by two pipers in full Scottish regalia.  
 Cable 10 will record the proceedings and a large crowd is expected, said owner Maureen Breen. Tickets are available now from the pub at \$15 a couple or \$10 a person.
