afield as Orillia. Teo Dragonieri, the artist who created the show, will talk about his work at the gallery on Sunday, Feb. 9 at 2 p.m.

"The exhibition seems to have struck a chord with people," noted gallery director/curator Christopher Jackson.

"Some people are fascinated with the craftsmanship, others with the wit and playfulness of the work. I'm having to add new sheets to the comment book almost every day."

Dragonieri started work on the series in the late 1980s, when he created the original Picasso Shoes. He has since added 49 pairs, each adorned with works in the style of specific artists, who range from Andy Warhol to Henri Matisse. While each pair is numbered and identified by a list on the wall, it's fun to test your artistic knowledge by guessing the artists represented. At present Dragonieri is negotiating to exhibit this fascinating series in Florence, Italy. Everyone is welcome to attend his Latcham Gallery presentation.

**LOCAL SPEAKER AT WOMAN'S SHOW**

Gwen McIver-Knox of Stouffville will be among the featured speakers at the fourth annual Toronto North Woman's Show, which takes place Feb. 8 and 9 at the Radisson Hotel in Markham.

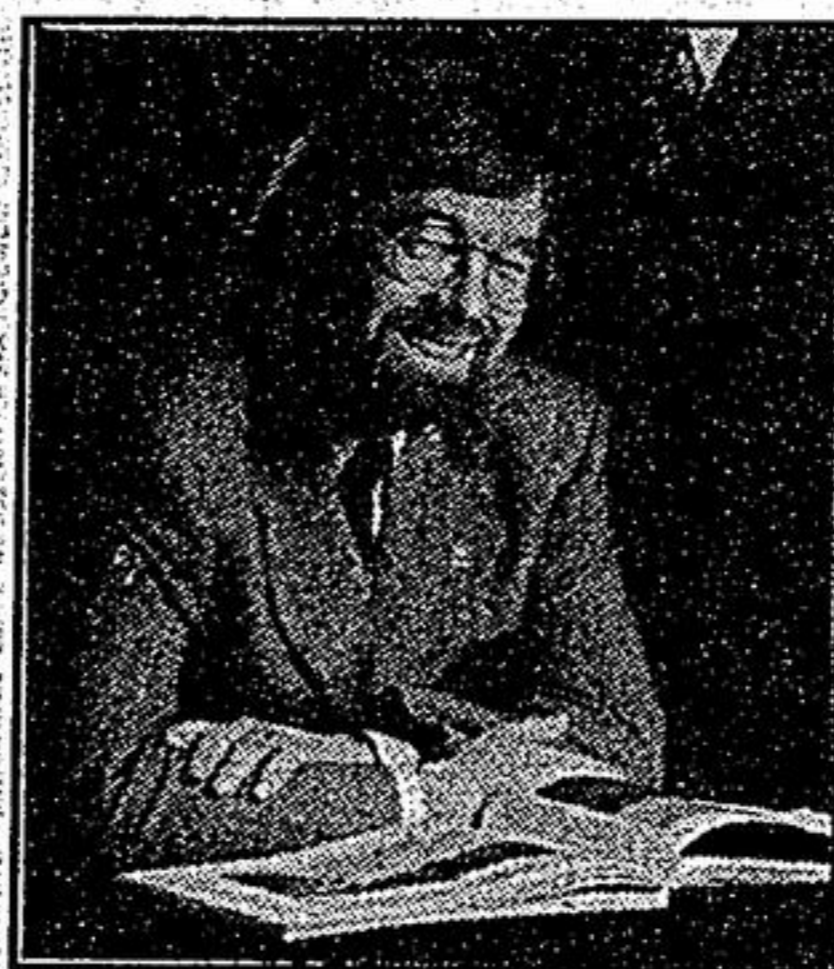
