

# Mayor's Series Golf Tournament set for July 17

Enough of January. Let's look ahead to what's coming up when the good weather returns next summer, and in summers to come. First off, the Mayor's Series Golf Tournament will turn three this year. Set for July 17 at the Maples of Ballantrae,

organizers are looking to raise \$15,000 for youth programs in town in an age when cutbacks have curtailed many activities for young people. Last year's event brought in around \$12,000, bringing the two year total to \$22,000. The money has been earmarked for the

second ice pad, youth softball and soccer, a skateboard ramp project, a day camp and youth theatre club. Any qualifying non-profit youth

group can apply for funding. The cost of this year's tourney is \$130 per golfer, which includes two meals, a gift (last

year's gift was a spiffy jacket), prizes, draws, entertainment and various on-course contests. Sponsorship packages

In accordance with the Municipal Act, notice is hereby given that the Council of the Town of Markham at its meeting scheduled for February 25, 1997, 7:30 p.m., will consider the enactment of an amendment to the Sign By-law, 121-93, as amended.

The Sign By-law regulates the erection of signs on buildings and on private property by establishing standards for their size and number, as well as prohibiting certain classes of signs.

The proposed amendment to the existing By-law is intended to limit the erection of signs at Market Village and is site specific applicable to signs at Market Village, an area located on the north east corner of Kennedy Road and Steeles Avenue.

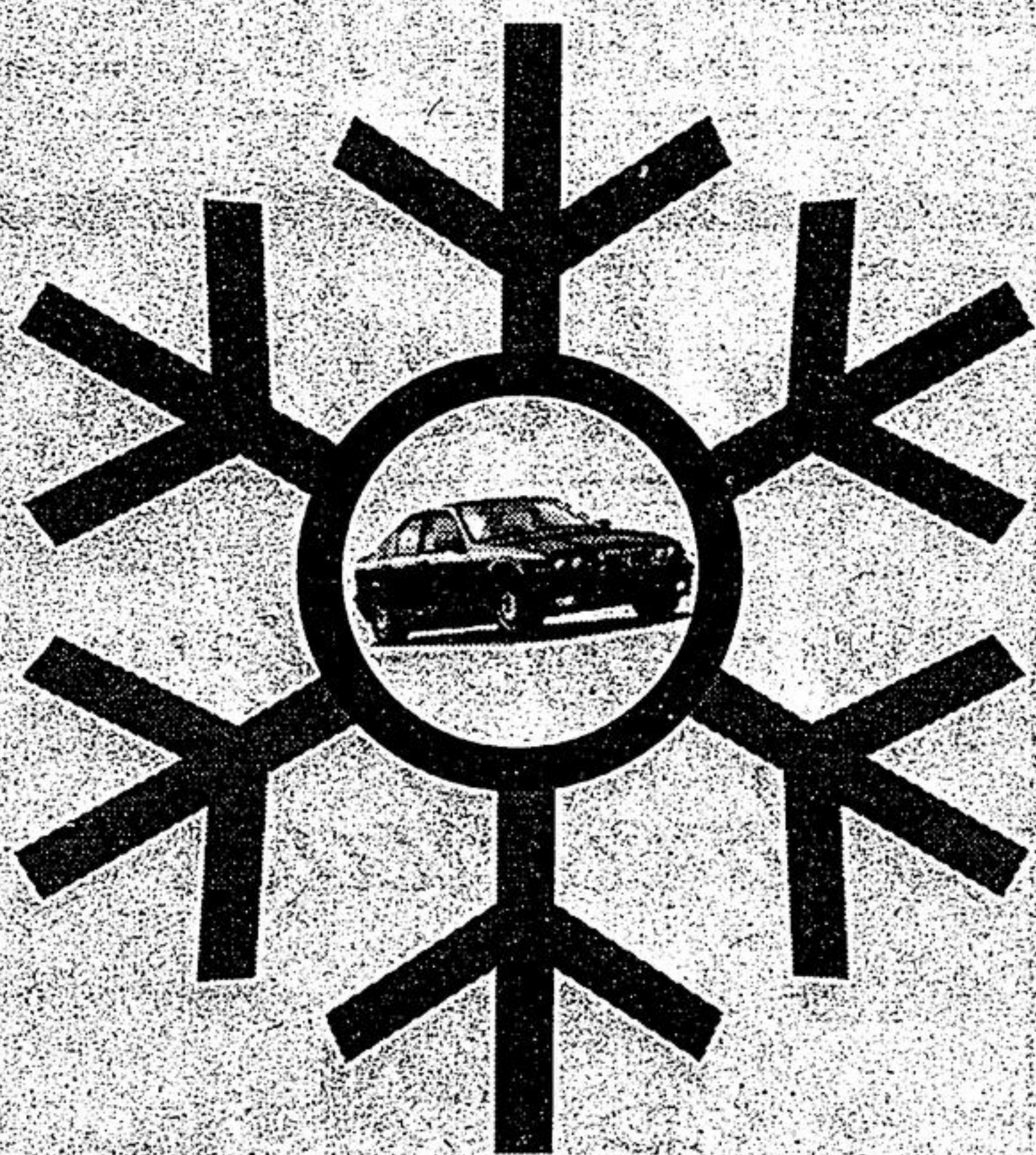
