Leukemia victim dies

A Stouffville family is grieving the loss of a 21-year-old cousin.

After a valiant fight against leukemia along with his family's struggle to find suitable bone marrow for transplant, Frank Ronco of Toronto died on the weekend.

No match was found despite the fact that more than 4,000 relatives, friends and strangers including many from Stouffville underwent tests at a cost of more than \$200,000.

The Ronco family held a one-day car wash in Stouffville and raised more than

\$3,000. The 27-year-old hair stylist was diagnosed with cancer on his return from his honeymoon about 18 months ago.

His Stouffville cousins Laura Ronco, Laura Gallo, Jenny Gallo and Jackie Gallo remind everyone that while time ran out for Frank, family efforts were not in vain.

The people tested may "help save another," said Laura Ronco.

Those tested in two local clinics are now listed on the Canadian Unrelated Bone Marrow Donor Registry.

Road Watch program begins

Motorists take note: Clean up your driving habits or else.

Road Watch, a citizens' watchdog committee, is in place - motorists who speed, run red lights and don't stop for school buses or stop signs risk being turned in by John and Jane Q. Public.

Details of the new safety program were outlined at a public meeting last week. A follow-up meeting will be held on March 4 at 7:30 p.m. at the Whitchurch-Stouffville municipal office. Ward 4 Councillor Cliff Dunkeld said measures will be taken to educate motorists about the importance of good driving habits.

The public's involvement is encouraged in order to curb a number of traffic problems taking place in and around Stouffville, said Dunkeld.

A councillor from Caledon is also helping set up the committee. Caledon has had success with a similar program, said Dunkeld.

Once Road Watch is up and running, such problems as speeding should be on the decline. If someone spots a motorist speeding or running a red light, he or she can take note of the licence plate number, the make and color of the vehicle and report it either by phone or by fax.

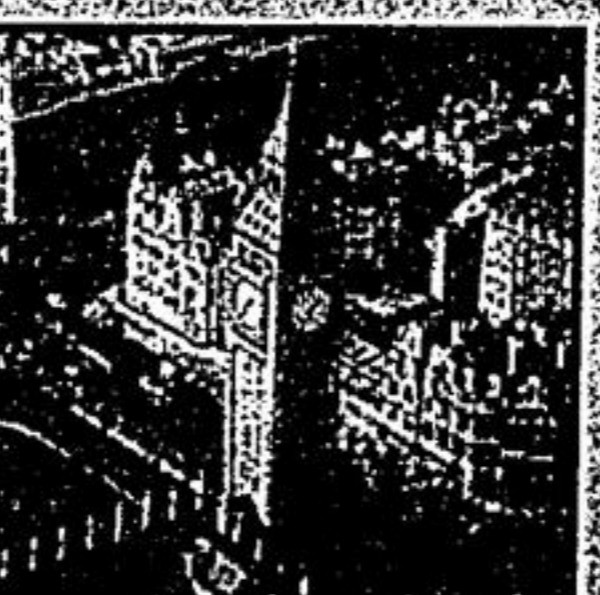
