Spirit conclude campaign on losing note

The Spirit put the lid on a trying second Provincial Junior A Hockey League season with a 9-1 loss to the Collingwood Blues on the road Friday before falling just short in a 7-5 defeat at the hands of the Lindsay Muskies Saturday night at the Rec Centre.

The Stouffville squad ended the season winless in their final 15 games.

Darcy King had the lone Spirit goal Friday. Tate Philips netted a pair Saturday, with singles going to King, Kevin Edgar and John Lowrie.

Spirit head coach Dan Larmer remained optimistic despite his team's lowly finish.

"It was a good way to end the season with a good effort like that against Lindsay Saturday," he said. "It's the end of the season and hopefully we've got all of the losing out of the way so we can get a fresh


start next year."

Larmer suggested a few fresh faces combined with a nucleus of returning players could make the difference between winning and losing the many games his team

lost by one or two goals this season.


Spirit general manager Wally Crowder wouldn't speculate on the team's future after a second season which saw the Spirit win only eight times.

"We're going to have a meeting sometime over the next week and figure out what's going to happen."
