

Cigarette article prompts call for further enforcement

The cigarette cops are coming to Stouffville. On Tuesday, Whitchurch-Stouffville council backed a plan designed to remind local merchants that selling tobacco to anyone under 19 years old is illegal. Council took action after *The Tribune* published the results of an informal survey showing that nine out of 10 Stouffville merchants sold cigarettes to minors in direct

contravention of the law. Council has invite the York regional health department to visit council and explain how the Tobacco Control Act is enforced. While a provincial law, it is enforced by regional authorities. Ward 4 councillor Cliff Dunkeld wants the authorities to go after the young smokers as well as the merchants. "If minors are caught, they should be reprimand-

ed too," said Dunkeld. Ward 5 councillor Judy Scala said taking issue with young people buying tobacco products is needed. "I support this fully," said Scala. Councillor Ivanka Bradley pointed out that in some municipalities in Ontario, the great majority of merchants obey the law making it difficult for minors to buy tobacco products.

MP loses appeal

The MP has admitted the letters were abusive but has maintained that they contained no threats. "Of course it was an unpleasant letter," Bhaduria conceded this week.

"Many MPs say more unpleasant things than what I wrote in the letter," added Bhaduria.

A decision in his favor would have been a "victory for the common man" in support of free expression, Bhaduria said. "It's a disappointment but I respect the decision of the highest court of the land."

The court ruled the Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation, obliged to represent Bhaduria during his appeals, including the November hearing, would not pay costs.

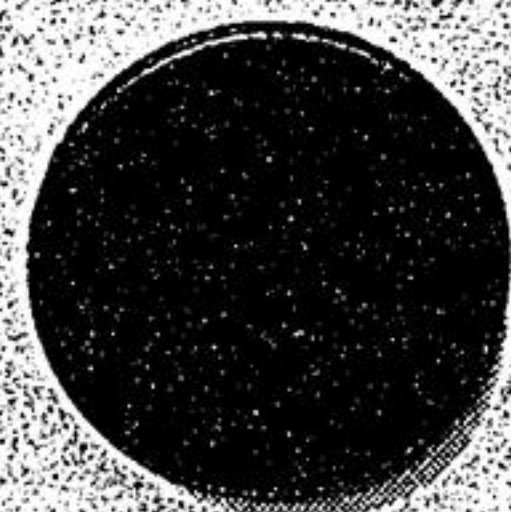
