Local bookseller takes part in Alphabet Zoo

John Lord will be at Metro Toronto Zoo April 19 and 20, but insists he has no intention of becoming a permanent resident.

Instead he will be representing John Lord's Books as an exhibitor at a special weekend event called Alphabet Zoo. The original inspiration for Alphabet Zoo sprang from conversations between Lord and Wayne Jackson, the zoo's public relations and marketing representative.

"John asked me about starting a private book sale for our staff," recalled Jackson. "I talked to my boss and he said we should include the zoo members and make it a fun day. From there, the snowflake became an avalanche."

A former resident of Uxbridge, he has been a regular visitor to the bookstore for the last three years and has worked at Metro Zoo for more than 22 years

"between working and travelling around the world. I've visited 24 countries and worked in 18 zoos, mostly for free," said Jackson, an expert on the animal kingdom, with a particular affinity for elephants.

"We tied this event in with Canada Book Day, which is on April 23," explained Lord.

"We're hoping to have at least 10 authors, and we'll have book readings by authors and volunteers," noted Jackson. "The main emphasis will be on children's books, but there will be adult books too."

Extensive media coverage is being planned, he added. "Global TV's Kids' Beat is very interested and we've also been in touch with YTV."

"We're trying to place authors who are doing readings in locations that relate to the topic of their book," said Lord. Children will be invited to test their word power by touring the zoo and finding an animal for

every letter of the alphabet and prizes will be awarded, said Jackson. Other exhibitors include Key Porter Books and Owl Magazine, which also publishes Chickadee, and which has recently introduced a new magazine called Chirp.

John Lord's Books will sell new and old books and a percentage of sales will be donated to the zoo. Each of the exhibitors will invite authors and illustrators to attend and sign copies of their books.
