Midget Clippers downed in semis

The Bouwmeister Landscaping midget Clippers were finally stopped in their quest for an Ontario Minor Hockey Association title.

The Clippers were downed 7-2 by Huntsville on the road in front of a hostile crowd Friday, giving the

hosts a three games to one triumph in the best-of-five semi final series.
