# Local legal imposter found guilty

In the legal world, a Stouffville man became the great imposter.  
 Yet, in early May, a real judge will hand out a sentence to fake the lawyer.  
 A Toronto jury found Stouffville resident David M. Kissen guilty of 10 fraud charges and one impersonation charge. The same jury also found Kissen's son Kirk Bambridge of Ajax guilty of one count of fraud.  
 The five-day trial for Kissen also known as David Kissodath and Michael Kissen wrapped up in a general division court late Friday.  
 Judge Victor Paisley ordered Kissen and Bambridge to return to court on May 7 for sentencing.

Kissen was first charged two years ago with impersonating a lawyer with intent. As well, police charged the 46-year-old with obstruction of justice.  
 Following more investigation, Toronto police and Durham regional police charged Kissen with a total of 10 separate counts of fraud, involving more than \$50,000.  
 The jury was told Kissen passed himself off as a lawyer unbeknown to court officials or his clients. Court was told that two years ago, while in a Toronto, Bambridge

identified himself as Kissen, while Kissen identified himself as Bambridge's lawyer.  
 The Law Society of Canada watched this case with interest. Having someone charge with impersonation is not a common occurrence. Crown attorney Sandra Backass told *The Tribune* the jury delivered the proper verdict. "It was the only thing they could do," she said. "Yes, it was an interesting case." Section 50 of The Law Society Act, deals with unauthorized practise, cleared the way for charges.
