Preserve Mother's Day cards in acid-free boxes away from light

On May 11, moms across Canada will receive more than 20 million greeting cards, making Mother's Day the third largest card-sending occasion of the year.

For many mothers, the artwork, poems and special messages contained in these cards

are mementos to save and cherish. To ensure that these cards stay in mint condition for years to come,

Kendall Wigoda, manager of corporate communications for Carlton Cards, offers these tips:

✓ To prevent cards from turning yellow over time, store them in acid-free boxes. These boxes can be purchased at most art supply stores.

✓ As the collection grows, do not jam the cards into one box; use

several smaller boxes instead. To guard against additional damage, keep at least one inch of space between the cards and box.

✓ If acid-free boxes are not available, wrap cards in acid-free paper or put them between acid-free

To display and preserve the most treasured cards, consider professional framing. Ask for an acid-free mat and display the finished product away from the light.

art boards. Many art supply stores carry these items as well.

✓ Do not use cellophane tape, glue or rubber bands to

secure cards. These fasteners will eventually deteriorate, causing damage to the cards.

✓ On the back of each card, write the date it was received.

If applicable, include the age of the child who sent it. This simple task will help keep memories fresh as the years go by. Don't forget to use a pencil. The graphite lead will last

indefinitely and will not damage the paper.

✓ Antique cards, such as those handed down from grandmother or great-grandmother, can be preserved in protective sleeves. The sleeves will protect the cards from humidity and damage caused by the sun or other bright lights.

Often, sleeves can be purchased at stores that sell photographic supplies.

✓ Keep the collection in a dry space, free from direct

light. For best results, the temperature of this storage place should remain constant.

✓ To display and preserve the most treasured cards, consider professional framing. Ask for an acid-free mat and display the finished product away from the light.
