

# Chrétien didn't have to call election: Senior

Canada can't afford another prime minister from Quebec, a Stouffville senior charges. Kim Rogers of Ballantrae doesn't want to see Jean Chrétien returned as prime minister on June 2. "We've had prime

ministers from Quebec for 28 or the last 30 years. "We've gone from having no deficit in 1967 to a \$600-billion deficit today," said Kim. Kim and his wife Margaret have lived in Ballantrae for 43 years. "I've worked hard for Canada and for myself. Canada is a wonderful country," said

Ridges Liberal candidate Bryon Wilfert about the campaign. "Why are we having this election?" Rogers asked.

Prime Minister Jean Chrétien called the election after serving 40 months of a 60-month mandate. "There's still one third (in the mandate) left. His (Jean Chrétien's) reasons are, at best, obscene," said Rogers.

While the campaign hasn't hit the half way mark yet, Margaret admits she's leaning towards the right. "I'll have to see how the campaign goes," said Margaret.

**Late addition makes six**

It's official — there are six election contenders in the riding of Oak Ridges. That's the number of candidates who were officially nominated by 2 p.m. yesterday, the last possible moment.

Names who will appear on the ballot June 2 are Dean Force for the Canadian Action Party, Liberal Bryon Wilfert, Natural Law candidate William Ayling, New Democrat Wynne Hartviksen, Progressive Conservative John Andersen and Reform candidate Edward Sarafian.

Force lives in Newmarket and Ayling is a resident of Huntsville, returning officer Michael Kennedy said.

Each candidate needed to give the returning office in Stouffville a list of signatures from at least 100 Oak Ridges voters, a \$1,000 campaign deposit, an official written endorsement from their party, and a letter from their financial agent.
