Basically Bagels opens on Main Street today

When it comes to bagels, Kass, Jim and Sam Kassam are experts.

Basically Bagels, which celebrates its official opening in Stouffville on June 16, opens for business today with a comprehensive menu which includes 18 flavors of bagels and 13 different cream cheeses, not to mention all day breakfasts, soups, salads and lunches.

"This will be our third location and we'll be setting up our fourth in Aurora," explained Kass Kassam, who studied hospitality and tourism at Ryerson University and whose family has been in the industry for many years.

He has worked for a number of high profile companies, including Howard Johnson, and he and his partners did extensive research in the U.S. before opening their first outlet in North York.

"I got my training down in the States, in New York, and we've been at our Keele Street location for about a year and a half - we just opened in Markham a couple of months ago and things have been going really well."

Kass Kassam divides his time between the three locations and he particularly appreciates the friendly, small

town atmosphere in Stouffville. Basically Bagels, which is at 6236 Main St., the former site of the Toronto-Dominion Bank, features beautiful wall murals and has a separate, fully ventilated area for smokers.

And the bagels themselves are made the original way, said Kassam. "We boil them first and then bake them."

In addition to offering bagels in every imaginable guise, the menu also features an excellent selection of beverages, including a range of specialty coffees.

Platters for office lunches, parties, special events and seminars are also available and patrons can purchase bagels by the dozen, along with a tub of their favorite cream cheese.

Basically Bagels is open Monday to Friday 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. and Sunday 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Clinic helps prevent falls in seniors

York Region Health Services is holding a Falls Prevention Presentation on Thursday, June 5, from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m., followed by a Falls Prevention Clinic on Thursday, June 12, from 10:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The presentation, by a public health nurse, will identify reasons for falling and tips to prevent a fall. At the falls prevention clinic, a public health nurse will complete an individual fall risk assessment including blood pressure check, balance test and falls history.

Falls are the sixth leading cause of death for seniors in Canada.
