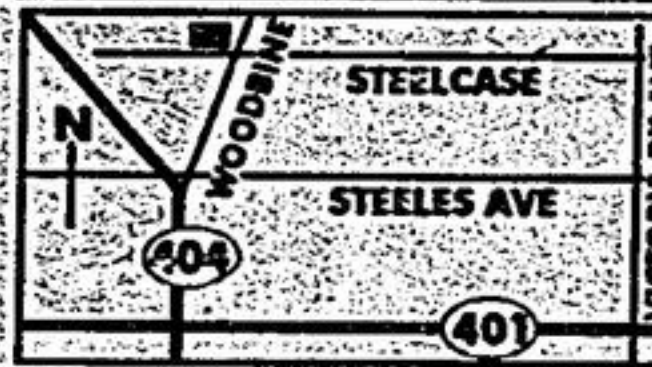

Strawberry social benefits the children of T.R.A.C.K.

St. Andrew's Chalmers' Strawberry Social will be held June 21 from noon to 3 p.m. at the Presbyterian church, which is located at 40B Toronto St. South in Uxbridge.

The third annual fundraising social will be bigger and better than ever and proceeds will be divided between the maintenance of the historic 140-year-old church and T.R.A.C.K. (Therapeutic Riding Association for Challenged Kids), said organizer John McCutcheon.

The registered, non-profit charity provides horseback riding therapy for children who are physically or mentally handicapped, as well as those with learning disabilities.

"Eighty children from the Uxbridge area, as well as Newmarket, Pickering and Stouffville, are taking advantage of this unique program," said McCutcheon.

"There is a waiting list however, and we are hoping visitors will be encouraged to give additional financial support and some of their time to helping these special children."

For just \$3 or \$4, which includes tea, coffee or juice, visitors to the social can choose

from a variety of treats, including generous servings of strawberry shortcake, strawberries and ice cream, and strawberries and cream, served with aplomb by Lance Brown, Dave Devall, Tom Gibney, Christine Bentley and Ken Shaw of C.F.T.O. TV, along with Uxbridge Mayor Gerri-Lynn O'Connor.

Live entertainment will be supplied by the 4 Dads and The Pineridge Chorus and a huge bake sale, with the emphasis on strawberries, will be held during the afternoon.

"We are hoping people from the Stouffville area will combine an outing on the train and a visit to the church," said McCutcheon.

Since it takes less than 10 minutes to walk from the station to the church, Stouffville residents can take the 10.35 a.m. train, which arrives in Uxbridge at 11.50 a.m., returning on the 3 p.m. train.

"Incidentally, visitors will have an opportunity to look through the sanctuary with its great beamed ceilings and its unique pew arrangement, which is almost in the round," he said.
