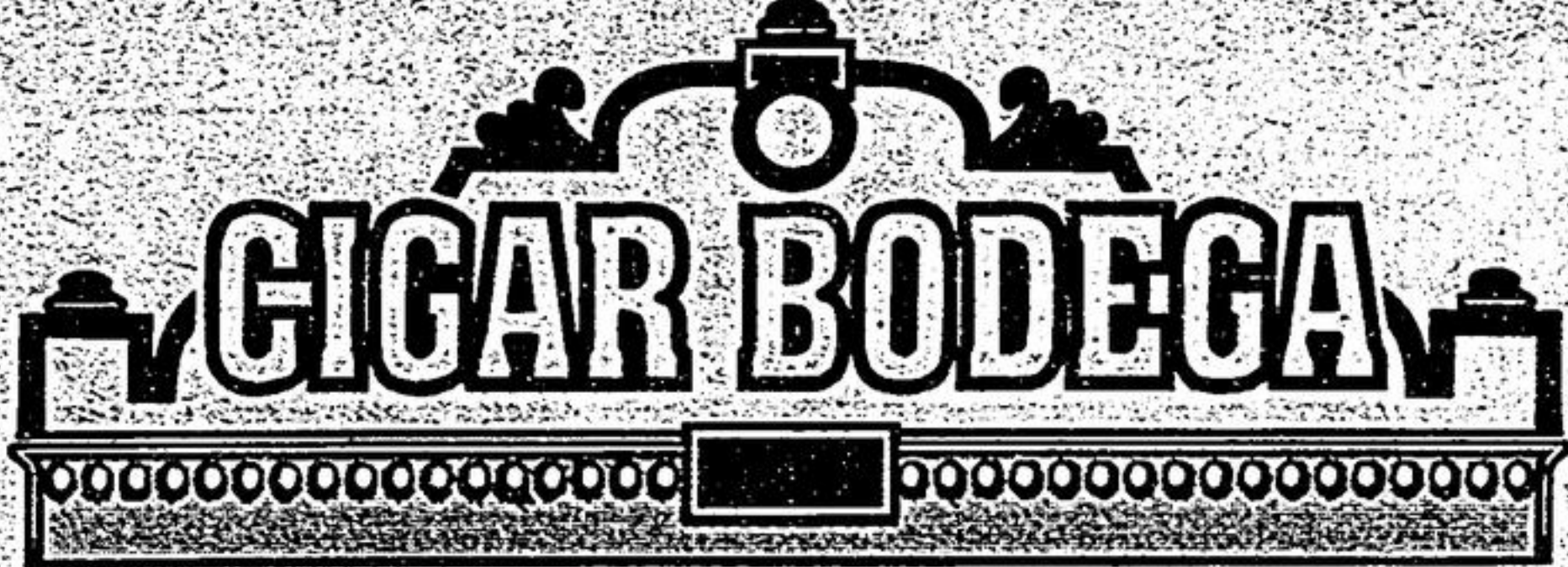

## Be thorough when washing car for dad

There are many gifts out there that show dad how much you appreciate him.

But if you are strapped for cash, the easiest thing to do - and very much appreciated - is give him a car wash gift certificate.

The following are some tips for cleaning the carpet:

Clean carpeting can go a long way in refurbishing the look of the interior.

But beware, the most common mistake in cleaning carpets is using too much water.

Excess moisture takes a long time to dry and can stay in the carpet, causing mildew and a musty smell, which leaves you worse off than before.

The first step is a thorough vacuuming. Whether you use your household vacuum cleaner or a heavy-duty coin-wash vacuum, be thorough.

Slide the front seats forward to

reach the carpet underneath. Remove carpet floor mats and do them separately. And don't forget the trunk or rear area.

Next, any stains or

cloth. If you own a wet-and-dry shop vac, this can make the drying process go faster.

When you've removed as much moisture as you can, leave the doors and windows open to allow air to circulate, through the interior. There is still moisture inside the car, if - when you close up the vehicle - there is a light misting on the windows.

At that time, you'll have to air out the car longer.

Once the carpet is dry, treating it with a fabric protectant can help resist future stains.

The most common mistake in cleaning carpets is using too much water. Excess moisture takes a long time to dry and can stay in the carpet, causing mildew and a musty smell, which leaves you worse off than before.

heavily soiled areas should be attacked with a carpet stain remover or general-purpose cleaning product.

Stubborn areas may require a multi-purpose degreaser, although you should experiment on an unseen location to make sure the color won't be affected.

To clean the entire carpet, use a stiff scrub brush and a low-moisture product such as a foaming carpet shampoo.

Following this, wipe the carpet with a dry, lint-free

### Fabric

Fabric seats and door panels are treated much like carpets.

First, vacuum up any loose dirt.

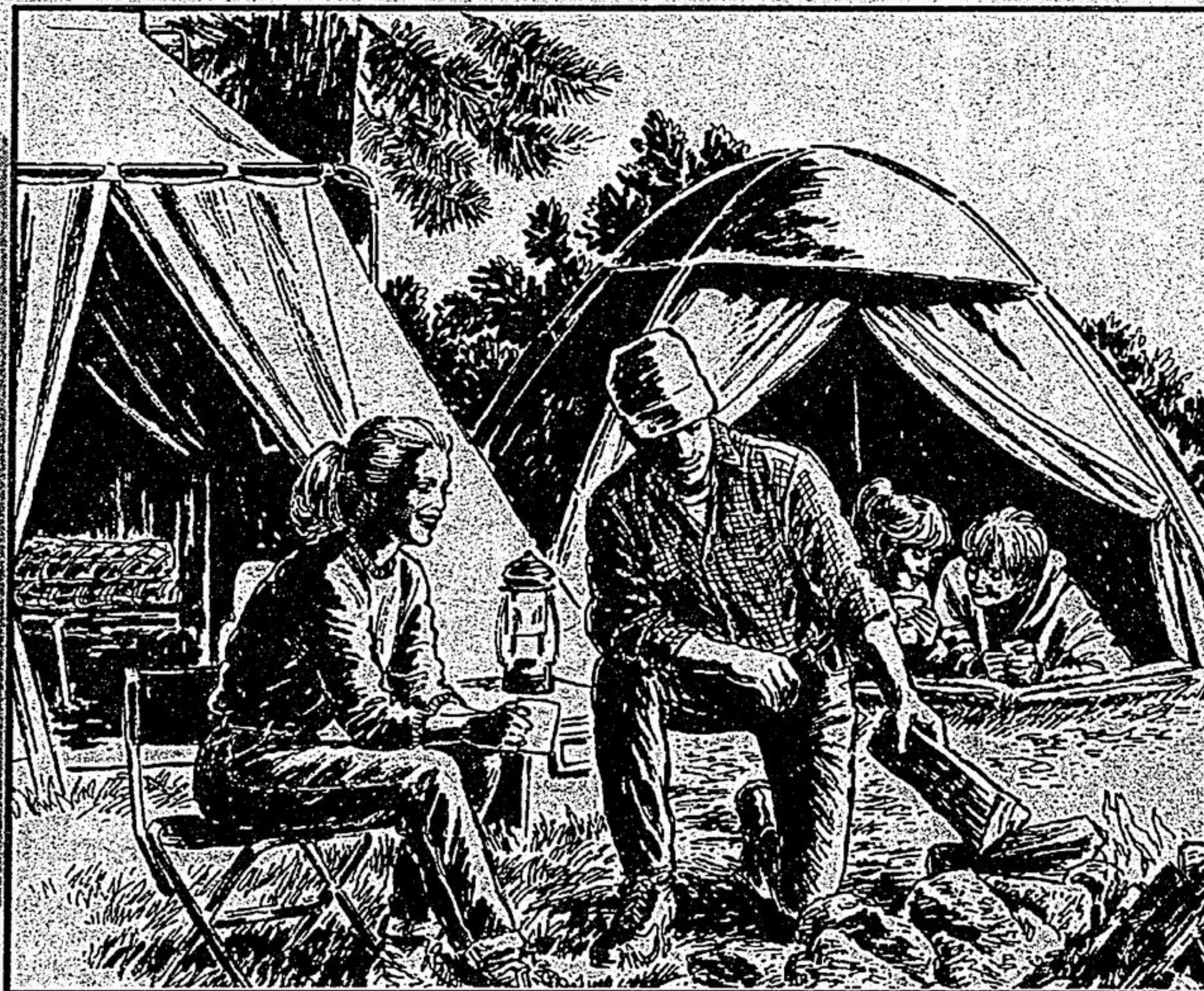
Then apply a light application of a foam upholstery cleaner.

Soak up excess moisture with a lint-free cloth, and then allow the car to vent for several hours until the fabric is thoroughly dry.

Once dry, it's a good idea to treat the fabric with a protectant.
