

Alzheimer Society Day Centre celebrates 10th anniversary with open house

The Alzheimer Society of York Region will celebrate the 10th anniversary of The Day Centre with an open house on Wednesday evening.

The centre, which is located on 18 Harlech Ct. in Thornhill, offers a five-day-a-week activities program for Alzheimer Disease victims living in southern York Region.

The society is to open a second centre in Newmarket in July to service the northern part of the region.

With the opening of the second centre, the society will be able to provide services for roughly 30 victims of the degenerative brain disease.

According to Day Centre director Sue Hart, the program has proved invaluable in providing for a better life for Alzheimer victims, while providing much needed relief for care givers.

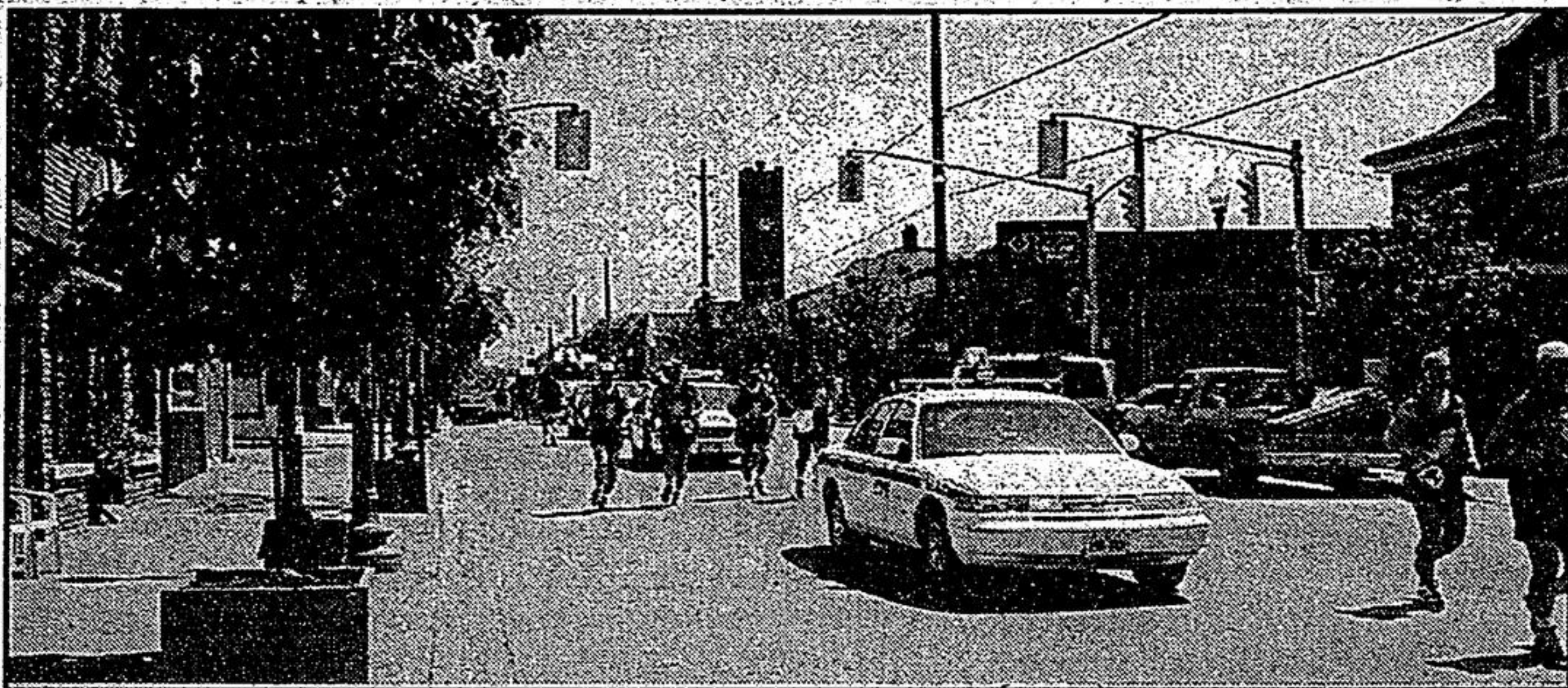
"The open house gives everyone a chance to celebrate 10 years of dedicated service by volunteers and staff," said Hart. "The new centre in
