

# Children can follow the 'Trail of the T-Rex'

Dinosaurs are a dynamite theme this season. First there was the release of *Lost World*, the movie based on Michael Crichton's novel about prehistoric beasts, and now it's the launching of our library's summer reading adventures (let's hear a trumpet blast!). The Trail of the T-Rex.

We know that local school children can barely wait to be released from classes for the summer so that they can dash down to the library and participate. The program, after all, is

an exciting adventure and one that's guaranteed to make reading fun even for the most reluctant readers.

Children can join the Trail of the T-Rex any time during July or August. During that time, each youngster reads six books on a variety of themes that are determined by the obstacles on a giant board game set up in the library.

The adventure starts with a blast-off through time to reach the lost world of Antedivulvia, where the giant Tyrannosaurus Rex guards a

fabulous treasure cave. The journey through time does not go smoothly when the time capsule misfires and the reader lands on the Planet of Librarius. From there, the trail back to prehistoric times moves through high seas adventures with pirates, a dual with a medieval knight and an escapade at the Tomb of Tutankhamun.

Children who participate are encouraged to read at their own pace and reading level. Preschoolers can also take part in the program with the aid of an adult reader.

Everyone who finishes reading the six books and reaches the treasure cave at the end of the T-Rex Trail, will be given a Summer Reading Award.

The greatest award for most children will be, however, the fun and achievement experienced along the reading trail.
