Child support group seeks volunteers



TOWNS OF AURORA AND WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE

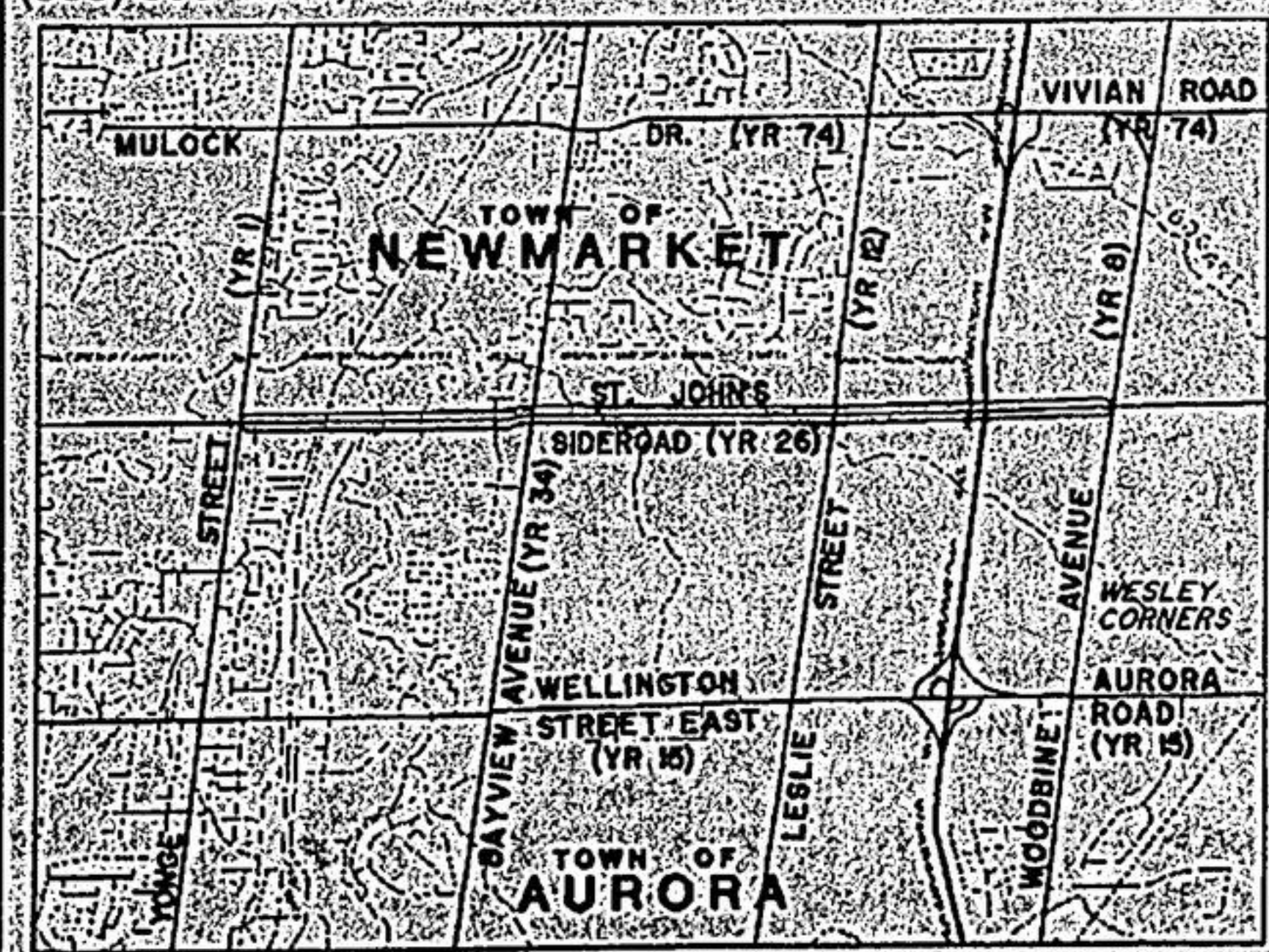
The Regional Municipality of York is studying transportation problems along St. John's Sideroad from Yonge Street in the Town of Aurora to Woodbine Avenue in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville (see study area map). The study will follow the Class Environmental Assessment process for Municipal Road projects. This means that public input will be sought throughout the study for incorporation into the final solution.

The Region would like to explore concerns with area residents at a Public Meeting to be held as follows:

HOW TO CUT LAWN CARE TIME IN HALF



Do half the work!
Mow your lawn and leave the clippings behind. It's called "grasscycling" and it really works. As they break down, clippings return moisture and nutrients to the soil. No need to water or fertilize as much.

Grasscycling — it's easy...

1. Keep the blade sharp and set at 5 cm or 2 inches.
2. Cut once or twice a week before the grass is too long.
3. Water deeply only once a week to prevent excessive growth.
4. Cut only when dry to prevent clumping (but never in a drought).

Also-

- consider fitting a mulching blade to your mower
- think about buying a mulching lawn mower if you need a new one
- if you use a lawn service, ask them to grasscycle

No more raking and bagging means more time for you!
