# Betz midgets finish third at provincials

The Betz Pools midget boys' fast-ball team fell just one victory short in their gallant comeback attempt to earn a ticket to Newfoundland over the Canada Day weekend.

The Betz brigade placed an impressive third out of 32 teams at the Ontario Midget Championships in Napanee, falling to the eventual finalist Hagersville outfit.

Hagersville was defeated by the host Napanee team in the championship match, with both squads advancing to the Canadian Midget Championships in Newfoundland.

The Stouffville squad led off the competition with wins of 9-1 and 6-3 over St. Mary's and new Dundee respectively Friday.

The Betz outfit didn't resume play until Saturday afternoon, when they were shaded 1-0 by St. Catharines.

The defeat put the Betz team on the tournament's losing side, but they bounced back to win four in a row to advance to the semi-finals.

Stouffville started off the run with a 6-4 win over O.R.S.A. before hanging a second loss on St. Mary's by a 7-1 count.

On Sunday, Stouffville downed Belleville 6-1 before avenging their only loss with an 8-4 win over Belleville.

But the Betz unit finally ran out of steam in a 9-0 loss to Hagersville. Betz left handed pitching ace Paul

Koert was named best pitcher of the tournament.

For the second straight year, Koert and Betz shortstop Evan Boyd were picked for the national tournament by the Napanee team, and will accompany them to Newfoundland.

Other members of the bronze medal winning Betz team include: Scott Assinck, Brett Boyd, David Clark, Chris Coyle, Norm Davis, Andrew Harper, Kevin Hackert, Mike McCauley, Mark Meyer and Dan Tardella.
