When you read this column I will be leading a group of 30 avid gardeners through the south of England.

As we travel along past gardens large and small there are several plants which we'll see over and over again.

One is the cheerful yellow bidens which is a part of almost all window boxes and hanging baskets. Another is the perennial form of lavatera in shades of pink and white. In England, it reaches heights of four to six feet whereas here it is killed back to the ground each winter and usually only becomes two-to-three-feet tall in one season.

The most popular shrub is the butterfly bush which reaches 10-12 feet. We treat this plant like a perennial cutting back the stems to six inches each spring so it

usually only reaches five to six feet here. Butterfly bushes grow so quickly and are so inexpensive that they can be treated as an annual and used in containers. They grow best in moist but well-drained soil with a full sun exposure. Once established, they are quite drought tolerant.

Botanically, the various butterfly bushes are varieties of Buddleia davidii.

The long wands of fragrant flowers are produced from mid-summer through fall and attract clouds of butterflies. Hummingbirds enjoy the nectar, too. The flowers may also be cut for bouquets.

There are several good varieties to choose from:

Black Knight has deep midnight blue flowers. Pink Delight is clear pink and White Profusion is silvery white. Slightly shorter in stature is Royal Red with rich wine-red flower spikes. Nanho Blue and Nanho Purple are naturally compact with silver foliage. Lochnich has silver grey foliage with lavender blue blooms - truly a cool combination for a hot spot.

There is a variety with variegated foliage and magenta-red flowers called Harlequin, but unfortunately it is of doubtful hardiness.

Buddleia weyrana, Sun-gold, has globular yellow flowers. No matter which color you choose the butterflies will come in swarms for they adore these plants. Undoubtedly you will enjoy some great

photographic opportunities.

It's not too late to purchase a butterfly bush to provide pure enjoyment for you and the butterflies this fall.
