Don Chase is an Onondaga Indian born in Port Hope, Ontario in 1938. He studied at the Ontario College of Art in Toronto and has devoted much of his life to research of Native Canadian Indians.

His art is marked with an overpowering naturalism and dedication to detail as a result of his extensive research into his heritage. Don's research, knowledge and love of Canadian Indians is reproduced in all his works whether sculptures or paintings.

Evolution of his own method of mold-making, Don's pieces are all "one of a kind". The original mold is broken away and the resulting figure can only be reproduced in bronze with his permission.

Creation of the Red Man, an 8 1/4" sculpture on display in the foyer of Tom Longboat Public School in Scarborough, Ontario. This extraordinary piece of art involving six months of hard work is a beautiful example of both his love for his heritage and his exceptional talent.

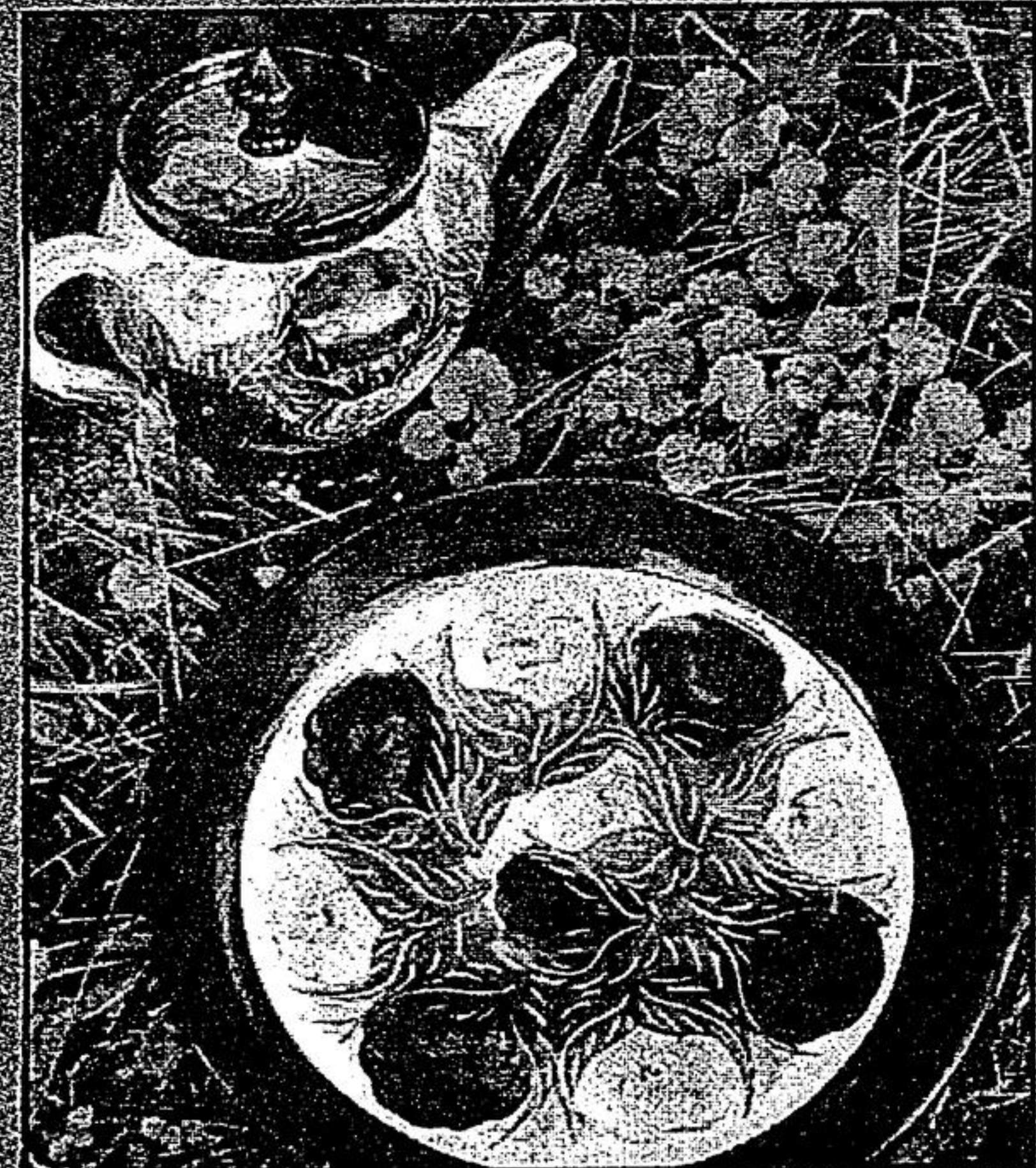

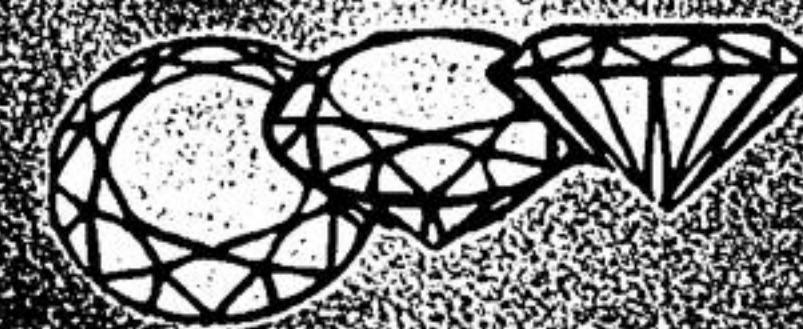
