

OPP asking all residents to be careful on long weekend

With the arrival of the Simcoe Day holiday weekend, the Ontario Provincial Police is asking everyone to pause at mid-summer to consider the safety of children.

The onus is on adults to act responsibly to prevent tragedies involving youngsters.

All terrain vehicles and personal water craft are not toys and must be treated with respect.

To avoid injury to operators and others, these powerful vehicles must be handled with care.

Children and youths are to be adequately instructed and supervised while enjoying the outdoors and must be equipped with the proper safety gear.

Serious injury can also be sustained by partici-

pating in non-powered leisure activities on land or water, such as bicycling, skateboarding, roller blading, canoeing and wind-surfing.

Adults must also make the right decision regarding the use and placement of a child restraint in a vehicle and remember not to expose smaller children to the risk of an air bag.

Last year during the August holiday weekend, six people were killed in traffic and four boaters died in incidents investigated by the OPP.

On the same weekend in 1995, the OPP investigated eight roadway deaths and seven boating

fatalities.

Frequently, alcohol is a contributing factor when people are injured or killed.

The OPP wants everyone to have a safe summer, whether engaged in seasonal activities or merely travelling to a favorite destination.

By putting safety first, residents and visitors to the province may enjoy another holiday weekend and a continuation of a pleasurable summer.

The Township of Uxbridge will be spraying roadside ditches and boulevards in the rural areas from August 7, 1997 to August 29, 1997, during daylight hours, Monday to Friday only.

The purpose of spraying is to kill the noxious weed Colt's Foot. The herbicide that is to be used is called Transline, registration number is 24085. Spraying will take place in rural ditches and boulevards only and be applied by a licensed applicator.

Spraying will only occur where Colt's Foot exists.
