Events planned include a parade, non-stop entertainment at the Community Stage, a children's sports and play area, and exhibits and displays in areas around the stage.

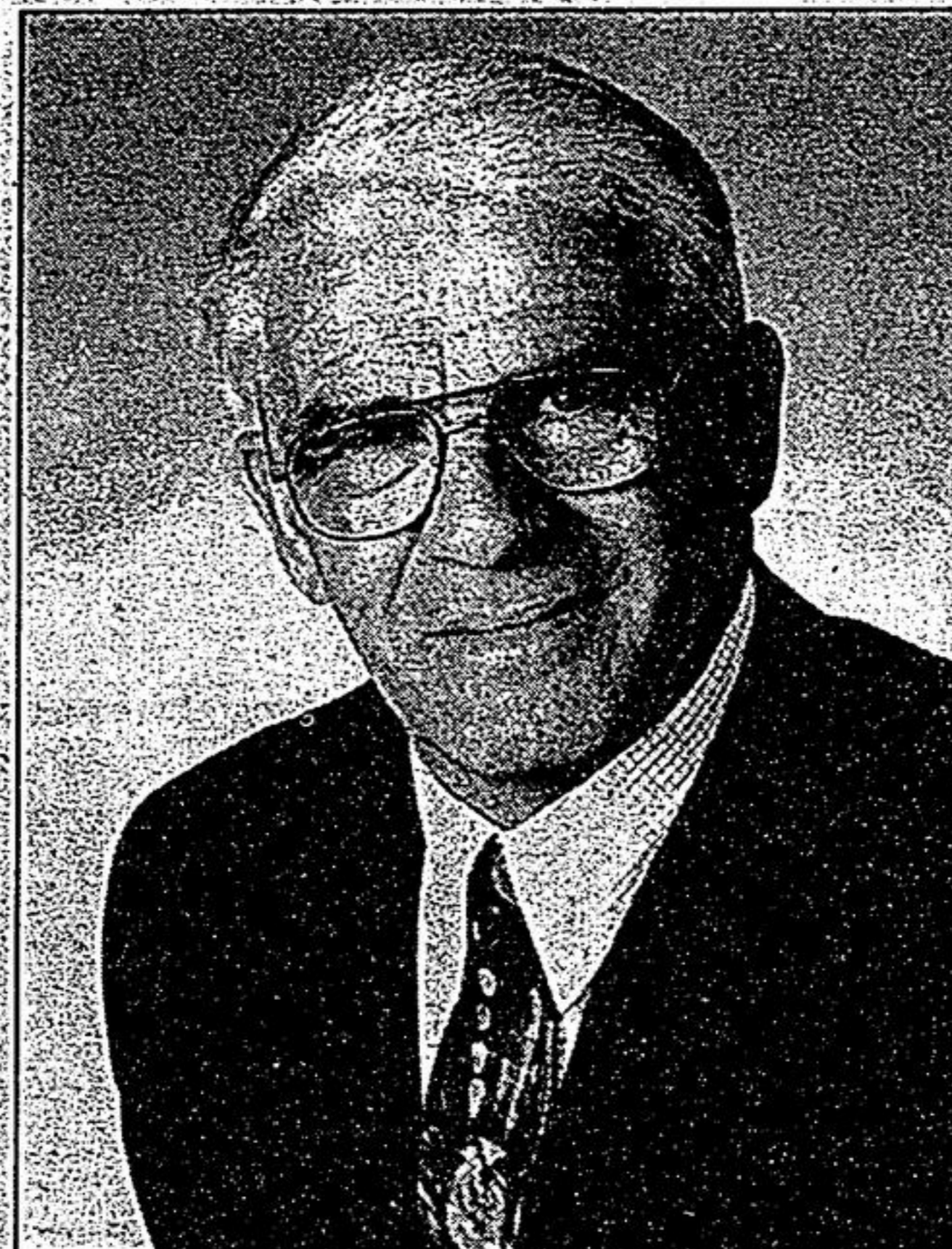

This promises to be a fun-filled and exciting day for everyone. I hope to see you at the CNE on York Region Day!



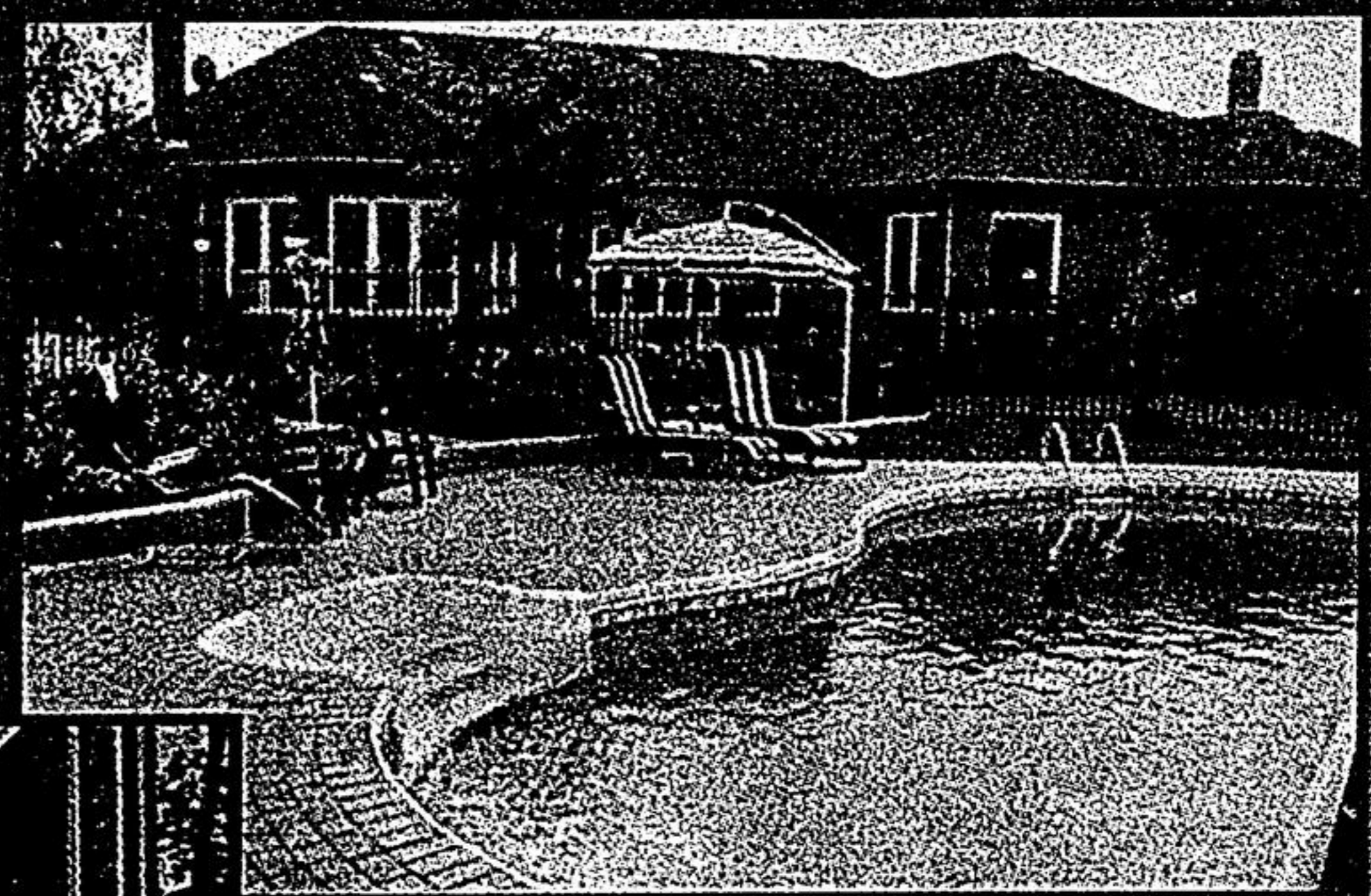
