**Group seeks singers**

A newly-formed community vocal ensemble, Rejuvenescence, is looking for young singers in York Region to audition for a place in the chorus.

The ensemble will consist of 30 to 50 people, aged from 15 to 22, who are interested in developing musical and performance skills.

It will also offer an excellent opportunity to meet like-minded people and to perform at concerts, festivals and community events.

Rejuvenescence is being established by Mark Caswell and Dawn Erwin and their project has already received support from Markham Mayor Don Cousens, the Town of Markham, York Region Optimist clubs and Capstone Communications.

"As co-directors of the ensemble, Dawn and I are looking for support in terms of financial contributions or sponsorships, partnership arrangements, performance opportunities or advertising exposure," said Caswell.

Erwin, who teaches vocal music, drama and special education at Markham District High School, earned her Bachelor of Music and Bachelor of Education from Queen's University in 1991.

She is a lead soloist in several jazz combos, sings with Concertsingers, a professional chamber choir and has directed mass choirs, chamber groups and small ensembles.

Caswell is a specialist in music from the University of Toronto and also teaches music at MDHS.

His extra-curricula activities include leading the Grade 10 Symphonic Band and two jazz bands and co-directing a concert choir and vocal jazz ensemble with Erwin.

Rejuvenescence will cover a variety of musical genres including classical, contemporary, folk, jazz, show tunes and world music. Rehearsals start Sept. 24 and take place every Wednesday from 7 to 9.30 p.m.
