**Terry Fox run Sunday**

The seventeenth annual Terry Fox run comes to Stouffville this Sunday.

This year's run starts at the Stouffville Recreation Centre at 1 p.m., but people can register anytime after 12 noon, and start the run up to 4 p.m.

The 10-kilometre route starts at the recreation complex on Ninth Line, weaves up to Main Street, along the Tenth and eventually wraps up back at the recreation centre.

Participants can run, ride, rollerblade, skateboard or walk along the route.

Organizers have a dedication board, where any participant can dedicate their participation to someone who they know who is living with or has died from cancer.

Last year, 480 participants raised \$25,072 in the annual Marathon of Hope in Stouffville, and \$184,000 has been raised since 1982.

Stouffville residents can make a pledge on run day, or pick up pledge sheets at any public library, Scotiabank, Toronto Dominion Bank or at the town's offices on Civic Ave.
