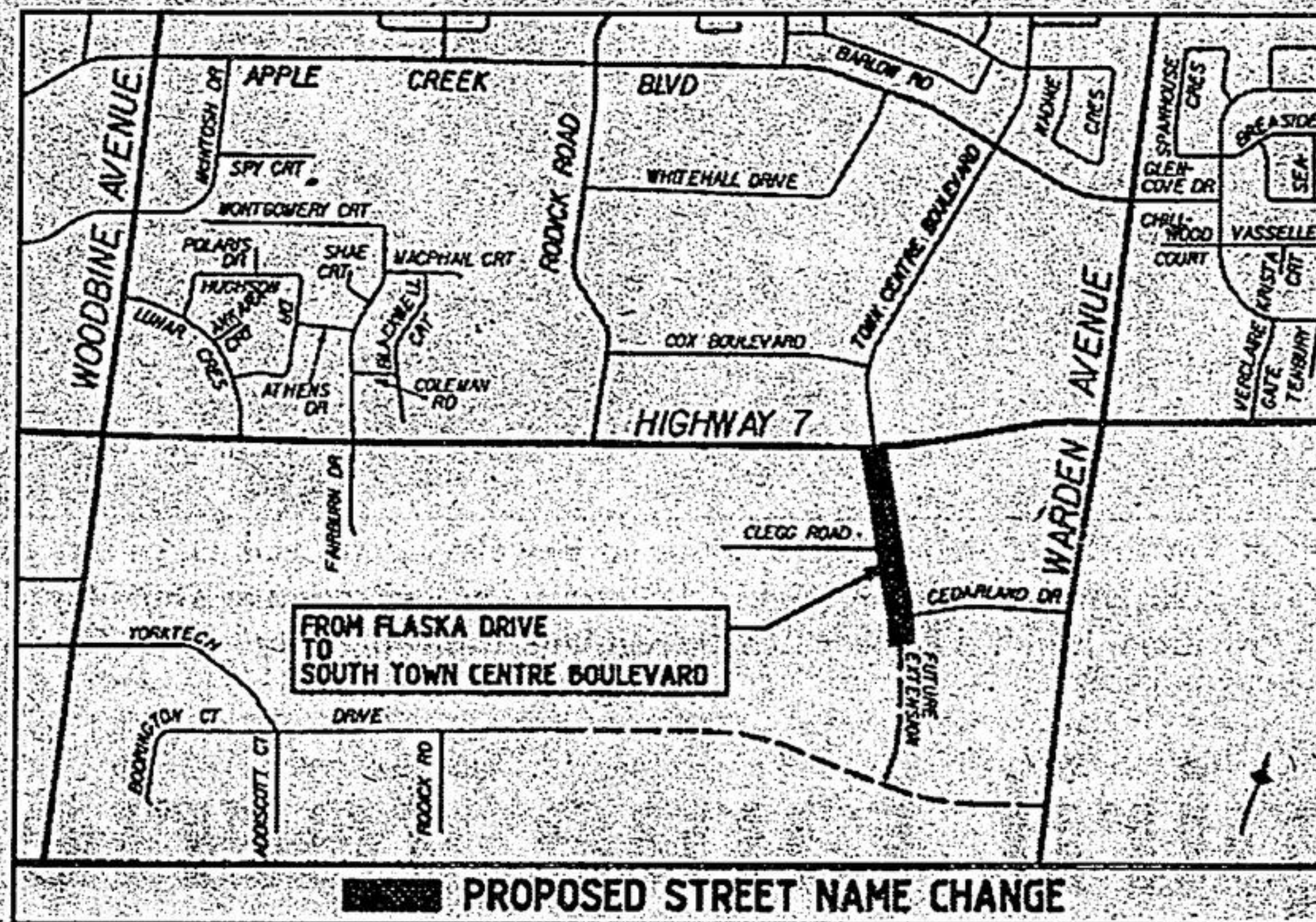

TAKE NOTICE THAT The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to pass a by-law to change the street name of:

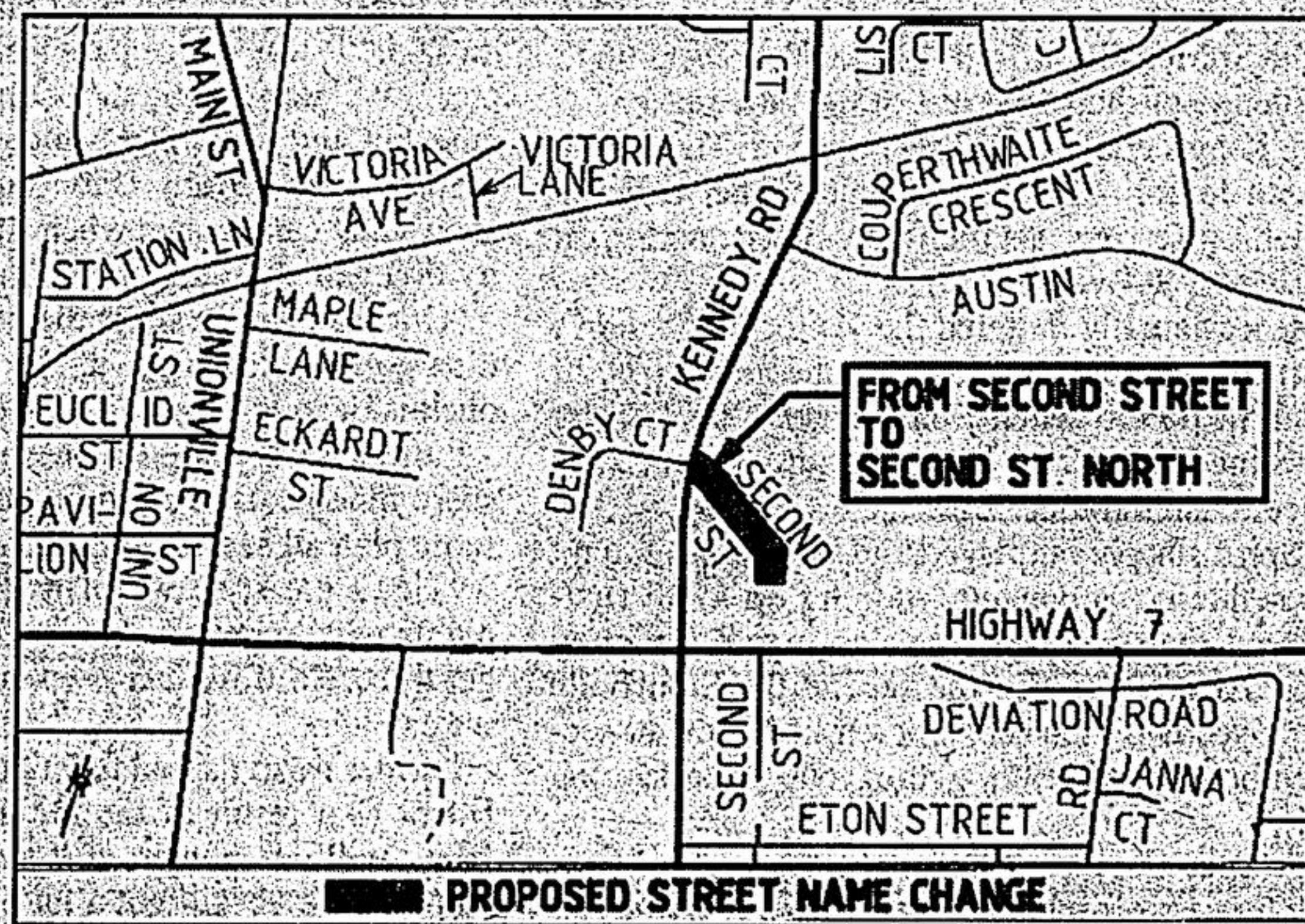
a) Flaska Drive to South Town Centre Boulevard on Registered Plan 65M-2668, Part of Lot 10, Concession 4:

Flaska Drive is being changed to South Town Centre Boulevard in accordance with the Town's objective to create a new mixed use "Town Centre" District extending south of Highway #7.



b) Second Street to Second Street North

Second Street, (north of Highway #7), is being changed to Second Street North at the request of the residents, due to a duplication of street numbering to the north and south of Highway #7 which may result in confusion and possible delay with Emergency 911 response.



The Council of The Corporation of the Town Markham shall hear any person who claims that his/her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-laws and may apply to be heard at a hearing to be held in the Council Chamber, Markham Civic Centre, on Tuesday, September 30, 1997, at the hour of 7:30 p.m.
