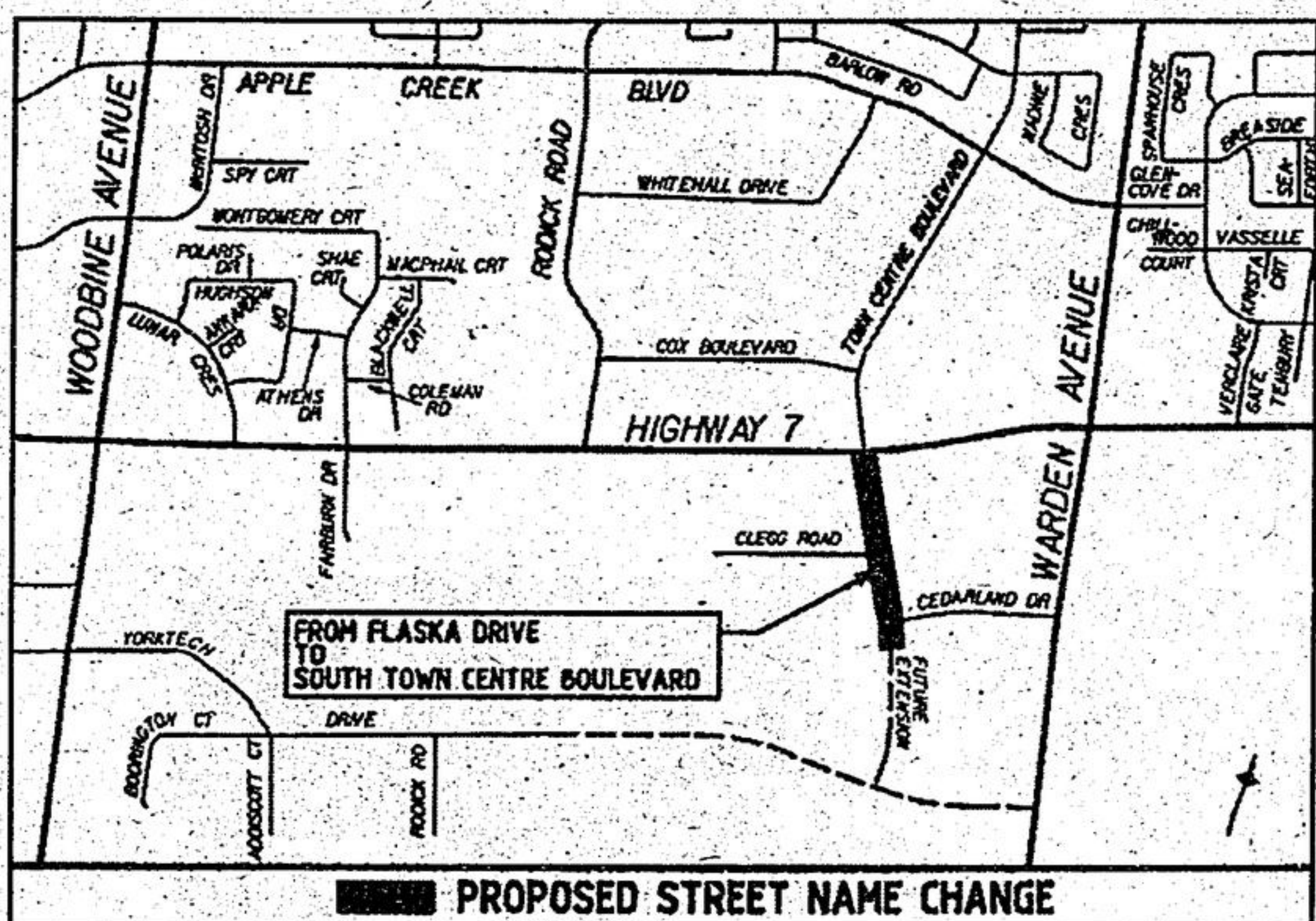

TAKE NOTICE THAT The Council of The Corporation of the Town of Markham intends to pass a by-law to change the street name of:

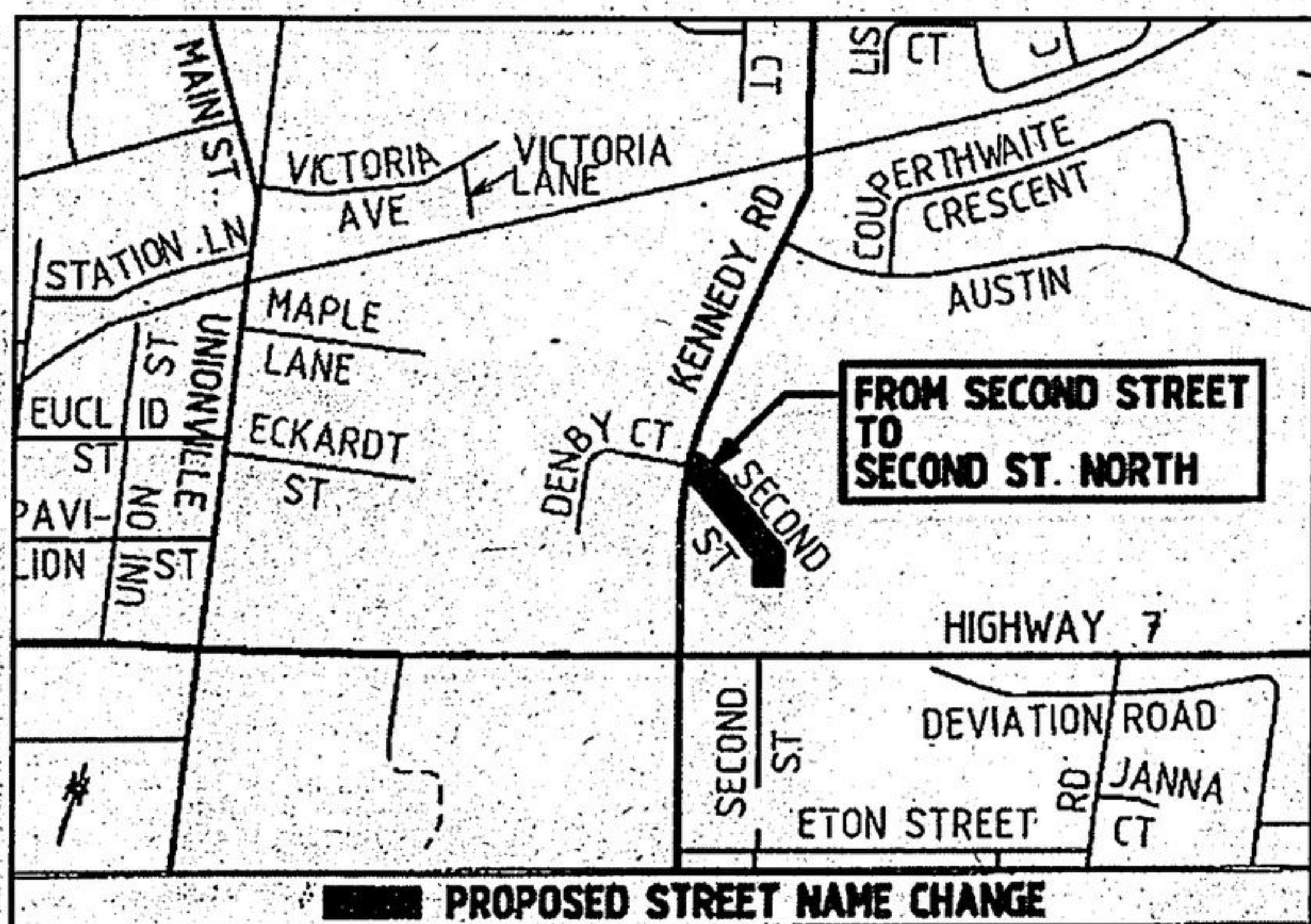
a) Flaska Drive to South Town Centre Boulevard on Registered Plan 65M-2668, Part of Lot 10, Concession 4:

Flaska Drive is being changed to South Town Centre Boulevard in accordance with the Town's objective to create a new mixed use "Town Centre" District extending south of Highway #7.



b) Second Street to Second Street North:

Second Street, (north of Highway #7), is being changed to Second Street North at the request of the residents, due to a duplication of street numbering to the north and south of Highway #7 which may result in confusion and possible delay with Emergency 911 response.



The Council of The Corporation of the Town Markham shall hear any person who claims that his/her lands will be prejudicially affected by the by-laws and may apply to be heard at a hearing to be held in the Council Chamber, Markham Civic Centre, on Tuesday, September 30, 1997, at the hour of 7:30 p.m.

Secondary Plan gets approval

After two years of deliberating, including a public review, Whitchurch-Stouffville has a new Secondary Plan for the downtown core.

The plan suggests a future population for the downtown area of Stouffville to be about 30,000.

On Tuesday, Whitchurch-Stouffville Council gave its blessing to the document.

It will be used as a guideline when determining what goes where when it comes to future planning.

The terms of reference for another secondary plan, this time for Vandorf and Preston Lake, will be reviewed at the next council meeting, slated for Oct. 14.

Low-cost rabies clinic offered in Stouffville next month

A low-cost rabies vaccination clinic will be held in Stouffville on Oct. 18 from 1 to 3 p.m.

Veterinary clinics across the Greater Toronto Area will vaccinate pets against rabies for \$10 for each pet.

The local clinic will be held at the Stouffville Veterinary Clinic at 5847 Main Street West.

Pet owners are reminded that rabies is a fatal disease for animals and humans.

Southern Ontario has one of the highest

incidence of rabid animals in North America.

Each year, Ontario health inspectors investigate about 32,000 cases of possible human contact with suspected rabid animals. About 3,000 people receive anti-rabies serum.

Health officials are concerned that this year rabid raccoons will arrive in Ontario from New York.

All local pet owners are encouraged to take advantage of the low-cost clinic.
