will be asked to carry out more surveillance when public events, including hockey games, are being held in town. "We're asking the police to come more often," said Emmerson.

Last weekend, a 14-year-old girl was so drunk, an ambulance was summoned to the arena. The drunk teen was taken to Markham Stouffville Hospital for treatment.

Witnesses said the girl had stopped breathing.

"She's home now but I understand it was serious," said Emmerson.

Drinking by about 40 teens triggered a melee at the arena. A fight broke out on the ice. It got worse when the drunk teens joined in.

Emmerson said he's not as concerned about the scuffles on the ice as he is about the drinking among the teens. On occasion, tempers will flare on the ice.

"But this other must be dealt with," said Emmerson.

The mayor is issuing a special appeal to parents.

"Know where your kids are. Find out what they're doing," said Emmerson.
