

# Log auction Oct. 25

Durham Land Stewardship Council and York Land Stewardship Council invite private woodland owners from Durham and York Regions to participate in a community log auction on Saturday, Oct. 25.

The auction will take place at 10 a.m., at the Main Tract of Durham Regional Forest in Uxbridge Township. The Ministry of Natural Resources, the Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Rural Affairs and the Ontario Woodlot Association are providing technical assistance and support for this initiative.

Woodland owners with potential log products should arrange for a free assessment of the suitability of their products for submission to the auction. Logs slated for auction will be picked up one week before the auction.

The purpose of this community log auction is to bring together buyers and sellers of local wood products and promote sustainable forest activities, forest health and diversity. Participants at the auction will have access to a wide range of information, services and products relating to woodlands. One service available, for example, is that buyers at the auction will be able to have their logs milled on site.
