

Orphaned crash survivor brought home by grandparents

The former pastor of a Gormley church has taken home his granddaughter who was orphaned and injured in an accident in Africa.

Rev. Jim Cober, former pastor of Heise Hill-Brethren Christ Church and his wife Doris took Sorina Cober, 3, to their home in Kitchener.

Little Sorina was the only survivor of a crash that killed the Cober Sr.'s son, daughter-in-law and 17-month-old grandson Jake. While Sorina suffered two broken legs and two broken arms, she'll make a full recovery, Rev. Cober told *The Tribune*.

The bodies of Sorina's father, mother and brother were flown to Canada for burial on Sunday. Rev. Mike Anderson, the current pastor of the Gormley church, accompanied a number of Gormley residents to the funeral.

Rev. Cober was the pastor in Gormley until the early '80s.

A love offering is planned for the local Bretheran Church. A trust fund set up by Toronto-Ambulance attendants raised more than

\$21,000 for the child.

Sorina, who was born to missionary parents, has no medical insurance. Immediately after the accident, she was flown here to be treated at The Hospital for Sick Children.
