Separate board salaries among best: Swimmer

From page 1 ■ financially," but it still has a real deficit, Swimmer wrote.

But if the York Catholic Teachers also drop a longstanding grievance, now worth \$18 million, against the board's allegedly illegal cut of 120 teachers, the board, in return, should restore one salary level, he advised.

It would be "a crude compromise to an expensive and complex problem," admitted the Carleton University professor, "but it is a way for both sides to declare a partial victory and move on."

It would also provide "tangible relief for what the teachers perceive as a great injustice," Swimmer suggested. Otherwise, he warned, the dispute "could lead to resentment by individual teachers which would spill over into the classroom."

The board said it planned to deliver a final offer to the union last week, and mediated talks with teachers were continuing. The union has said its members will vote on the offer and hold a strike vote Oct. 24.

Union officials were not available for comment. Swimmer said teachers "must also accept" that the other salary increments could be restored, and that their total compensation could be increased, only "through (other) monetary and workload concessions" from teachers.

That could include accepting a board proposal to fix the pupil-teacher ratio in schools on Oct. 31 enrolment, instead of the (probably larger) number of students enrolled on Sept. 30, Swimmer suggested.

The factfinder dismissed the union's own staffing suggestions aimed at reducing the PTR and the number of "split grade" classes, saying the teachers "seem to be caught in a time warp."

Even though their salaries have been frozen for five years, the teachers know their current salary grid "is among the best in the province," Swimmer said, and added the union should not expect any increases from a two-year contract unless they agree to take on more work. "Perhaps the public will eventually react to the decline in educational quality, and demand a change to government policy," Swimmer added, "but that provides little solace for the present."

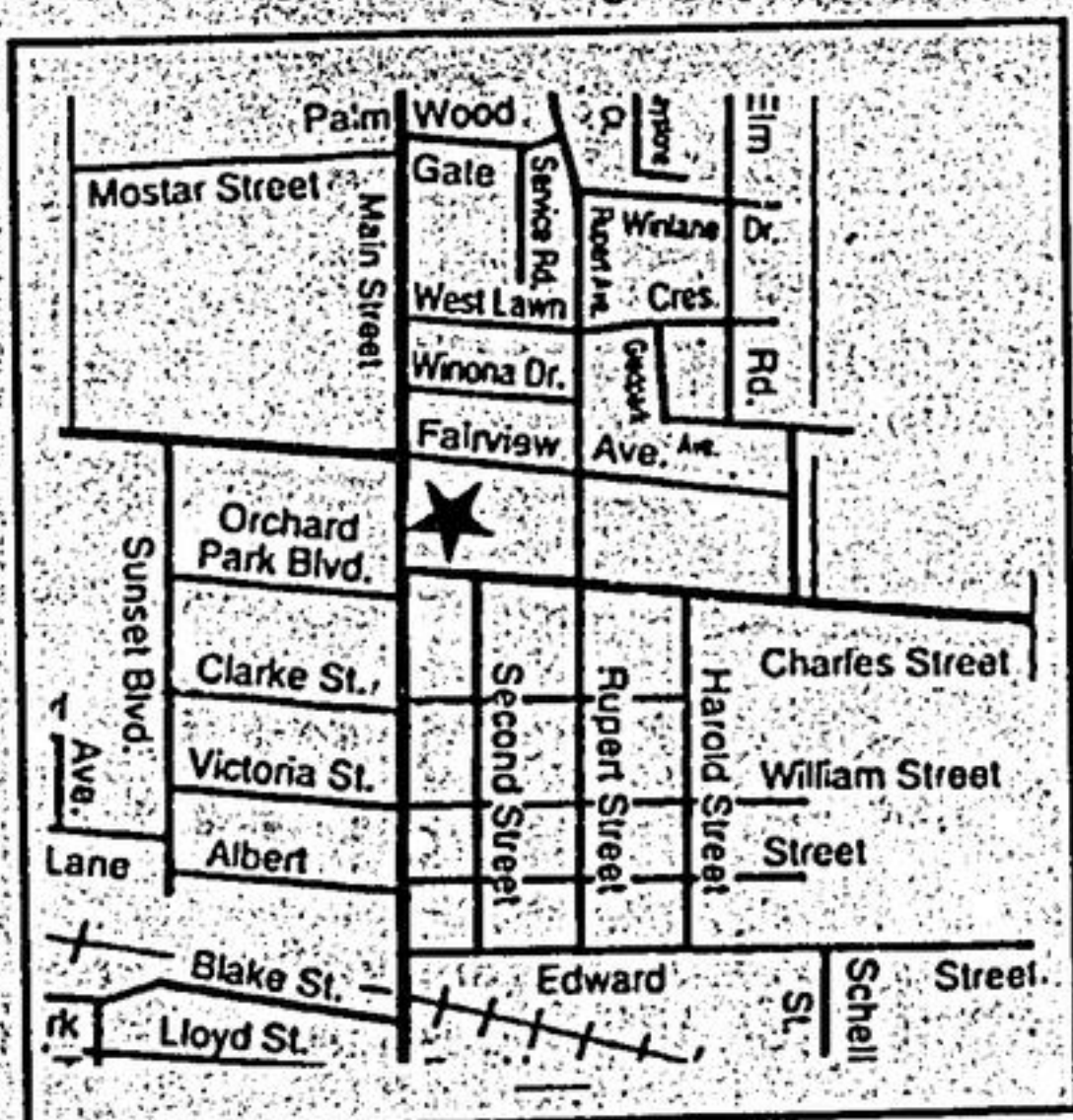
