What you wear to the wedding depends on the time of day

(SOP) The time of your marriage ceremony, coupled with the degree of formality you wish for your wedding day, usually determines the appropriate clothing to be worn by members of the wedding party.

Ceremonies before 6 pm are considered daytime affairs, while evening affairs commence at 6 pm or later.

While simple, elegant styling is

considered in good taste at any hour, evening celebrations allow participants to wear more elaborate attire.

Use this chart as a guide for the proper dress code, and then start looking through the pages of bridal guides to find your dream dress, your bridesmaids' gowns and formalwear for the groom and groomsmen.

Your mother and your fiancé's

mother should wear dresses that complement each other in style and in color.

Both fathers should wear formalwear identical to that of the groom and groomsmen.

Formal Daytime

Bride: Floor-length gown with train and coordinating veil accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Bridesmaids: Floor-length or tea-

length dresses accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Groom and groomsmen: Cut-away coat, gray striped trousers, gray vest, ascot or four-in-hand tie; optional top hat, spats and gray gloves.

Mothers: Floor-length or tea-length dress ensemble accessorized with jewelry, gloves, shoes and hosiery.

Formal Evening

Bride: Floor-length gown with train and coordinating veil accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Bridesmaids: Floor-length or ballarina-length dresses accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Groom and groomsmen: Black full dress with white wing collar formal shirt, white pique vest and bow.

Mothers: Floor-length or ankle-length dress accessorized with jewelry, gloves, shoes and hosiery.

Semi-formal daytime

Bride: Floor-length, tea-length or ballarina-length gown with short veil or pouf accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Bridesmaids: Floor-length or tea-length dresses accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Groom and groomsmen: Gray stroller with striped trousers, pearl-gray vest, four-in-hand tie with white pleated formal shirt; optional hornburg and gloves.

Mothers: Floor-length or tea-length dress ensemble accessorized with jewelry, gloves, shoes and hosiery.

Semi-formal evening

Bride: Floor-length, tea-length or ballarina-length gown with short veil or pouf accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Bridesmaids: Floor-length or tea-length dresses accessorized with jewelry, gloves, hosiery and shoes.

Groom and groomsmen: Black tuxedo, white pleated formal shirt, bow tie, vest or cummerbund to match tuxedo lapels. White dinner jacket with formal trousers for summer/tropical climate.

Mothers: Floor-length or ankle-length dress accessorized with jewelry, gloves, shoes and hosiery.

Everyone is invited to the

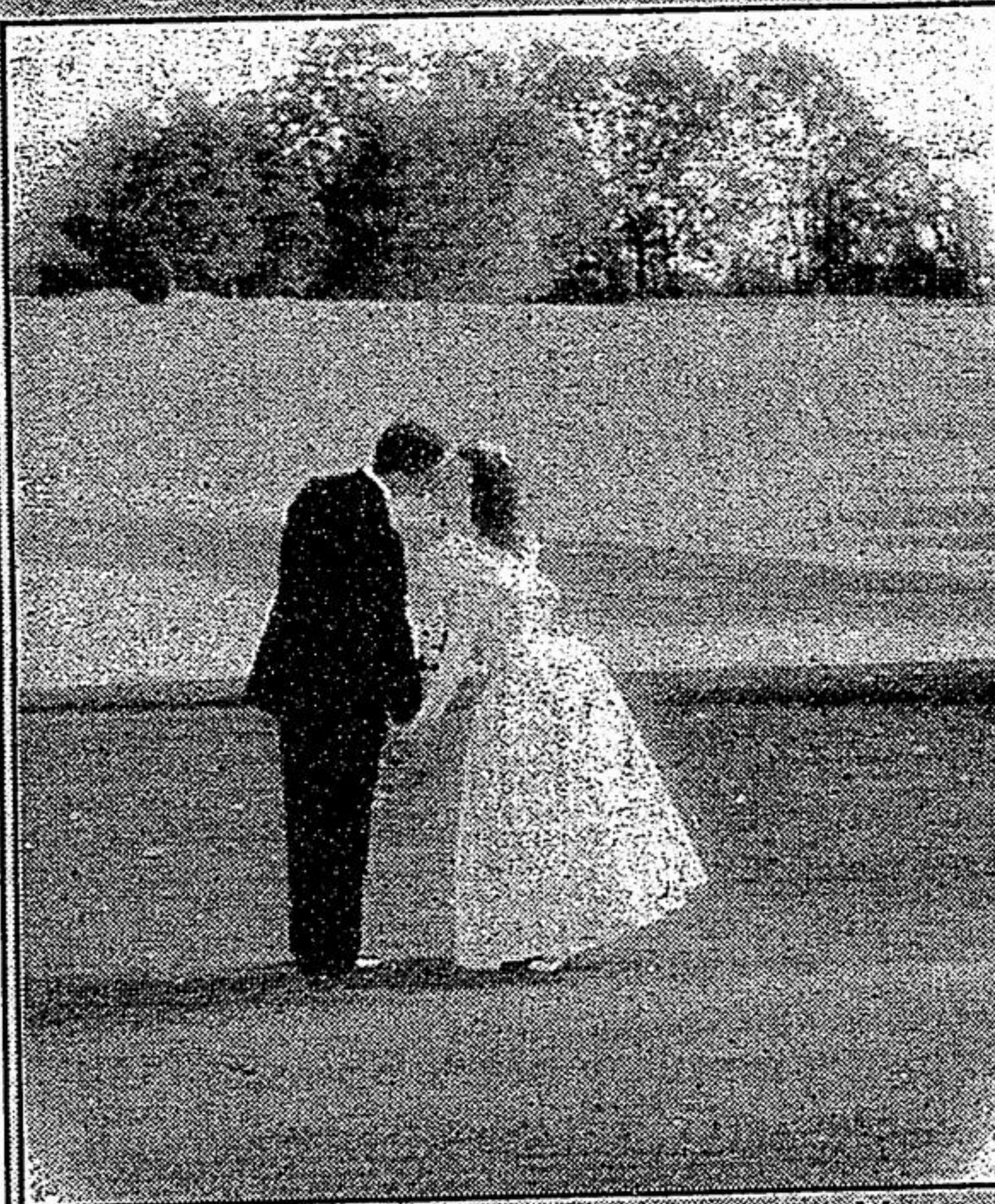
show. People can purchased tickets in advance (which are cheaper) or at the door. Booths are still available.
