Crash victim still recovering

An 81-year-old woman is in serious condition after a car accident north of Uxbridge last Friday.

Police said Joyce Ward, of Saint John, New Brunswick, was a passenger in a Pontiac driven by Blanche Taylor of Goodwood.

Taylor and Ward were eastbound on the Sandford Road around 10:25 a.m.

According to police, the Pontiac entered the intersection at Durham Rd. 1 and was broadsided by a northbound GMC pick up, which struck the passenger side of the car.

Ward was taken to North Durham Health Services, Uxbridge with life-threatening injuries. She was later transferred to Sunnybrook Health

Science Centre, where she remains in serious condition.

Taylor was treated and released at North Durham Health Services in Uxbridge. The driver of the truck, Bruce Smith of Uxbridge, and his passenger, Ross McKinnel of Guelph, were taken to the Uxbridge hospital with minor injuries. Both were treated and released.

The cause of the accident is under investigation.

Harvest tips

As grain harvest begins farmers and workers are reminded that flowing grain can act much like "quicksand" and once a person is caught up to their knees there can be no escape. You should not enter a grain bin or wagon when grain is flowing.

If one must enter a bin or wagon, basic entry procedures for confined spaces must be followed:

1. All mechanical and electrical equipment must be locked out to prevent accidental start-up.

2. Use the buddy system and wear a life-line. Sufficient equipment and manpower must be available. The extra person is there to monitor the situation and to summon assistance if needed.

3. Test the atmosphere for oxygen and toxic gases. If the silo is sealed, there could be a lack of oxygen or toxic build-up of gases.

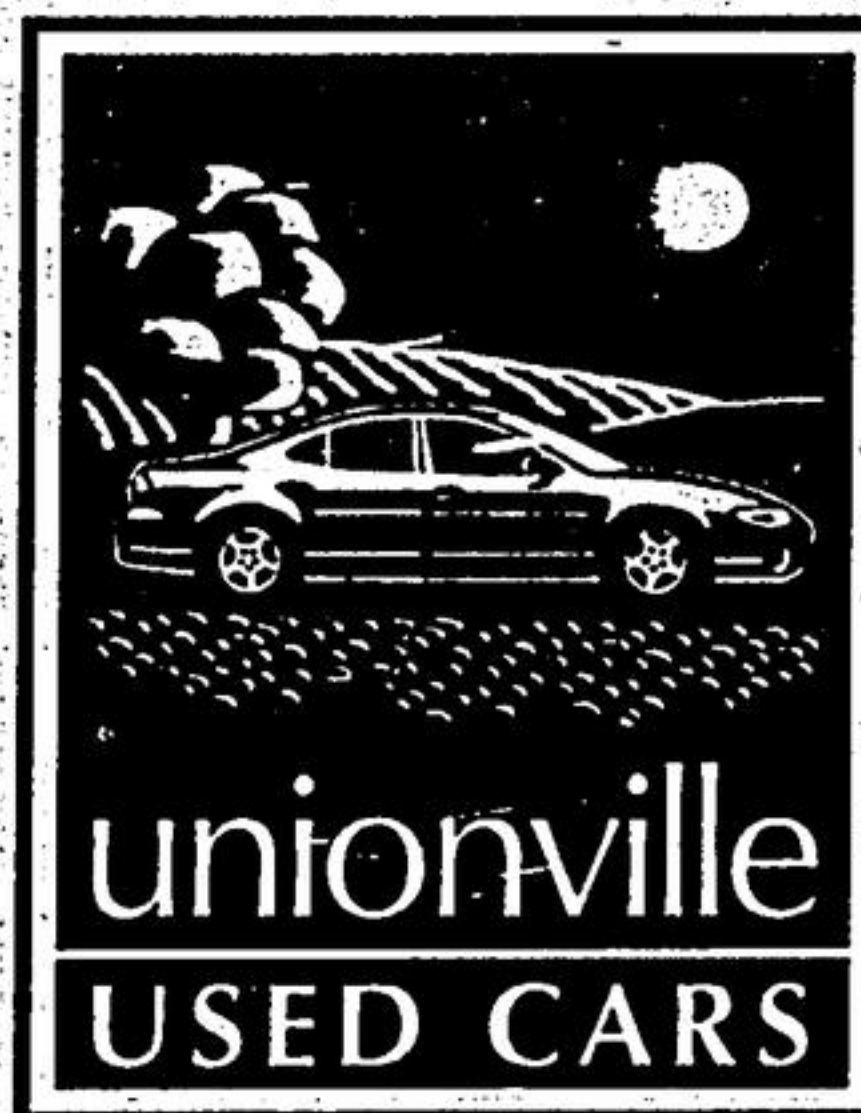
