

# Land for Life planning process now on the 'Net

The latest developments in the Lands for Life planning process are now available on the Internet, Natural Resources Minister Chris Hodgson announced today.

"This is the latest step in our efforts to ensure that people have access to information about

Lands for Life," said Hodgson. "Lands for Life will determine the best ways to protect and maintain our natural resources, and we want to consult with as many people as possible."

Lands for Life is a planning process that will guide long-term

decisions on the use of Crown land in order to ensure sound management of Ontario's natural resources. To facilitate the process, Ontario has been divided into three large ecologically-based planning units) Boreal West, Boreal East and Great

Lakes-St. Lawrence) that cover 46 million hectares of Crown land. Planning recommendations will be developed by three round tables.

The Boreal West, Boreal East and Great Lakes-St. Lawrence round tables are made up of envi-

ronmentalists, Aboriginal peoples, tourism operators, recreational users and representatives of resource-based industries. The round tables are currently holding several public meetings and will present the Minister with their recommendations by March 1998.

The Lands for Life Internet site contains information on what the Lands for Life planning process is, area maps and all the publications and documents the Lands for Life process has produced. For those who don't have Internet access at home, computers with links to the Internet are available in various public buildings, such as libraries and schools.

The three round tables have also set up reading rooms where the public may find out about Lands for Life. All of MNR's Lands for Life information on the Internet is available in paper copies in the reading rooms, along with an introduction to the process and policy documents.

The Great Lakes-St. Lawrence Round Table has set up 13 reading rooms, the Boreal West Round Table has established 11 reading rooms and the Boreal East Round Table reading room is at the District Office in Timmins.

Along with the Internet site and the reading rooms, brochures are being mailed out to the 300,000 holders of outdoor cards. The brochures give an overview of the Lands for Life process, as well as addresses to contact to get on the mailing list of each round table.
