Gribbon's goal was all the Spartans needed in a 1-0 win over Markville S.S. on Oct. 9.

The Spartans, who were YRAA champions in 1995, will be out to regain their crown when the playoffs

The team was still awaiting results of other team's final regular season games at week's end, so both the site of Monday's quarter final, and the SDSS team's opponent were unknown at press time. If successful in Monday's game, the Spartans will contest the YRAA semi-finals Wednesday in Newmarket. The championship game will take place Thursday at King City H.S.
