of UNICEF's mission to help children, Zellers would like to help parents keep their children safe during Halloween celebrations and offers a list of safety tips.

Parents and children can review Zeddy's Halloween Safety Tips together to ensure a fun and safe Halloween.

- ✓ Keep visibility in mind when buying and creating costumes.
- ✓ Bright fabrics are best and you also can decorate costumes with reflective tape. Bags or sacs also should be light-colored.
- ✓ Costumes should be short enough so that children will not trip and fall.
- ✓ Tie hats and scarves securely

to prevent them from slipping over eyes.

- ✓ If your child wears a mask, make sure it fits securely and has eyeholes large enough to allow full vision.
- ✓ Makeup also is a great alternative to masks.
- ✓ Ensure your paper or cloth decorations cannot be blown into a flaming candle.
- ✓ Ensure your yard is clear of such things as ladders, hoses, dog leashes and flower pots that can trip trick-or-treaters.
- ✓ Know the route your children

will be taking for trick-or-treating.

- ✓ Ensure trick-or-treaters are accompanied by an adult or a teenager.
- ✓ Set a time when children should return home.
- ✓ Send a flashlight along.
- ✓ Know what other activities children may be attending, such as parties.

- ✓ Although tampering is rare, children should bring candy home to be inspected before they consume any tasty treats.
- ✓ Ensure that children eat dinner before setting out so they are not tempted to snack on their loot.
- ✓ Explain the difference between good tricks and bad tricks.

### The art of carving a pumpkin is made easy

If you're like most of us, carving a Halloween pumpkin brings back strong memories.

There's the unforgettable smell of the fresh insides and the feel of the slimy goo between your fingers.

Here's the basic knowledge you will need to carve your own special jack-o-lantern.

1. Cut a lid in the top. Remember to angle it inward so the lid sits on the pumpkin and doesn't slid inside.
2. Scoop out the seeds and inside fibres. Leave about one inch of pulp

pumpkin.

You can cut the features out of the pattern and attach it to your pumpkin with tape. Use a pen or pencil to trace the features onto the pumpkin.

5. Working from the centre of the design outward, cut out the pattern.

Try to cut straight into the pumpkin and not at an angle.

If you use a knife with a serrated blade, use a gentle sawing back and forth motion.

7. When you have completed the carving, put a candle inside

and light it. After a few minutes, lift the lid and put the candle out. Cut a small hole at the smoke-blackened spot on the lid to vent smoke.
