Local MP talks CPP to residents

Bryon Wilfert, Member of Parliament for the riding of Oak Ridges held the first community council meeting on Thursday, Oct. 16.

The meeting was attended by 23 residents who represent the three riding municipalities of Whitchurch-Stouffville, Richmond Hill and northern Markham.

Wilfert updated the members on current issues in Ottawa, and the remainder of the evening was spent discussing the Canada Pension Plan reforms.

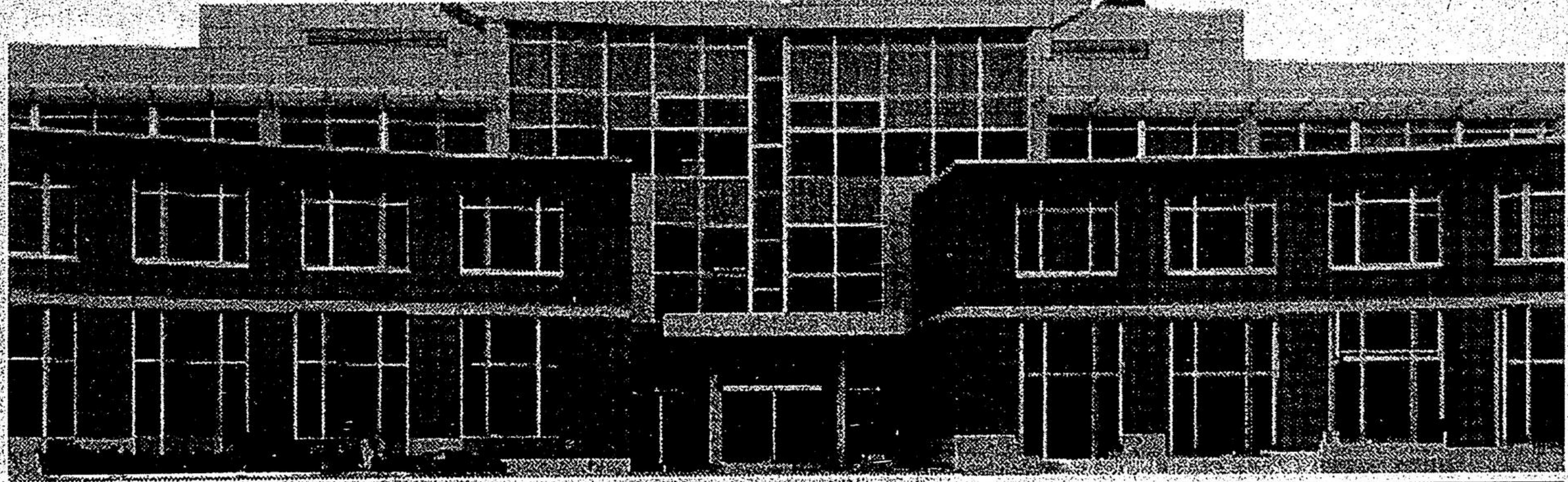
The participants provided grassroots comments on the issue and provided excellent suggestion Wilfert will be formulating into a letter that will be presented to the Minister of Finance, Paul Martin for his consideration. Also, Wilfert will be raising the comments at the national caucus meeting.

Wilfert said, "I believe that the community council is an excellent opportunity to listen directly to my constituents and to discuss the issues in-depth."

He went on to say he had promised to do this during the election and added, "I look forward to meeting with the council regularly."

Members agreed to hold these meetings on a quarterly basis, with the issue of pre-budget submissions being the next area for review in January. Other future topics will include youth employment and environmental issues.
