Strike 'two' for separate board teachers

Catholic teachers in York Region are on strike today and — as of this Monday — they could be on strike.

But that would be a legal strike over a new contract, instead of the current illegal "protest" against the province.

Local teachers voted 91 per cent in favor of a strike Friday after rejecting — in 96 per cent of 2,400 ballots cast — an "appalling" offer from York Region's separate school board.

And Monday, the local federation president said he would give the board five days notice of a strike.

"If this mess with the government ends, they'll have another mess to deal with," said Ihor Baczynsky of York Catholic Teachers.

"I don't think they're prepared to deal with it, and we certainly don't want it," he added.

If the teachers strike during the strike, they'll be the only ones in the region drawing strike pay.

Teachers from both area boards aren't getting strike pay now because, technically, they're not actually on strike.

Restoring the three years of pay levels denied teachers during the Social Contract is the top issue in dispute, although there are others.

Other Greater Toronto Area boards

have been restoring the increments, but York's separate board can't afford that without some concessions from teachers, a provincial factfinder concluded in a report.

Further contract talks were planned for Tuesday and Wednesday with mediator Olive Chester. "Hopefully the board will realize their final offer was a non-offer,"

Baczynsky said. Board chair Tina Molinari said she was disappointed that teachers spurned the two-year offer, which would freeze their salaries, benefits and staffing levels.

"We are committed to working with our teachers' union to reach an agreement," she said earlier this week in a press release.

Park are respecting her position "I made it known in advance. I was reassured that I have their respect as they have mine."

Many principals in Ontario are supporting the teachers in opposing Bill 160. Summitview principal Wallace Robinson said he's joined his teachers on the picket line "before hours." Wallace is optimistic. "This is going to be

over." As the strike enters its fourth day, people are becoming especially sensitive. "People have strong feelings," said Wallace.

The two teachers who crossed the picket line at Summitview were not the only ones refusing to talk to the newspaper. While most Stouffville teachers were eager to talk to the media on Monday, all striking teachers at Summitview declined comment Tuesday.

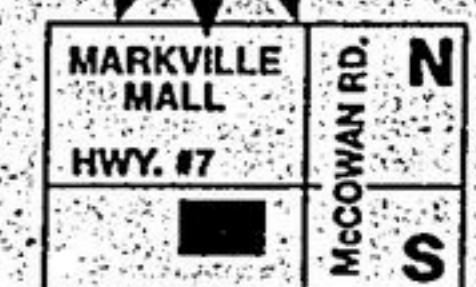
