

Dump off hazardous wastes at three-day depot

York Region's successful waste management program is back again.

Building on the popularity and success of Household Hazardous Waste Days during the last seven years York Region will once again host a temporary depot for three days.

The depot will operate on Thurs. Oct. 30, Fri. Oct. 31 and Sat. Nov. 1 at the Ray Twinney Recreation Complex in Newmarket.

It will be open from 11 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. on the Thursday and Friday and 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the Saturday.

The site is located on Eagle Street just west of Yonge Street. Last year the program welcomed approximately 3,000 vehicles over a 3-day period at this site.

York Region residents may bring household hazardous wastes to the depot at no charge.

Household hazardous wastes include cleaning agents, automotive fluids, pesticides, paints, medicines, solvents, batteries, propane cylinders, medicinal needles and syringes and a variety of other toxic, corrosive, flammable or irritating chemicals. Motor vehicle tires also will be accepted.

If you have any doubt about a product look for one or more of the following hazardous materials symbols that may be on the container:

- the skeleton hand, indicating corrosive materials
- the skull and crossbones, indicating poisons;
- the exploding fragments, indicating pressurized items such as aerosol cans or propane cylinders; and
- the fire, indicating flammable products.

Because of their impact on the environment, none of these materials should be disposed of in the garbage, poured down a drain, or buried in the yard.

Residents dropping off hazardous wastes should bring the materials to the site in their original containers, or safely packed in well-marked containers.

Residents dropping off needles or syringes are asked to bring them in rigid, closed containers. No containers can be returned. Staff from Hotz Environmental Services Inc. will accept the materials and arrange to recycle or dispose of them safely.

Details about the Household Hazardous Waste Program are being advertised throughout York Region.
