

Lake resident wins journalism award

The Southern Ontario Newspaper Guild recently announced the presentation of a journalism award to Mus-selman Lake resident Blair McQuillan.

Blair McQuillan, who is the news editor for Stouffville-based Blue Line Magazine, is studying journalism at Durham College.

He was recognized by the Southern Ontario Newspaper Guild for academic achievement in journalism. The award includes a cash prize as well as a recognition dinner to be held in November.

"The award came as a complete surprise to me," McQuil-lan said. "It's an honour to be recognized by your peers."

McQuillan has been working for Blue Line Magazine for more than four years. He first came to the magazine in a journalism co-op program from secondary school. His talent was immediately recognized and his first assignment turned into the cover story for the November 1993 edition.

McQuillan was later offered a permanent position with Blue Line.

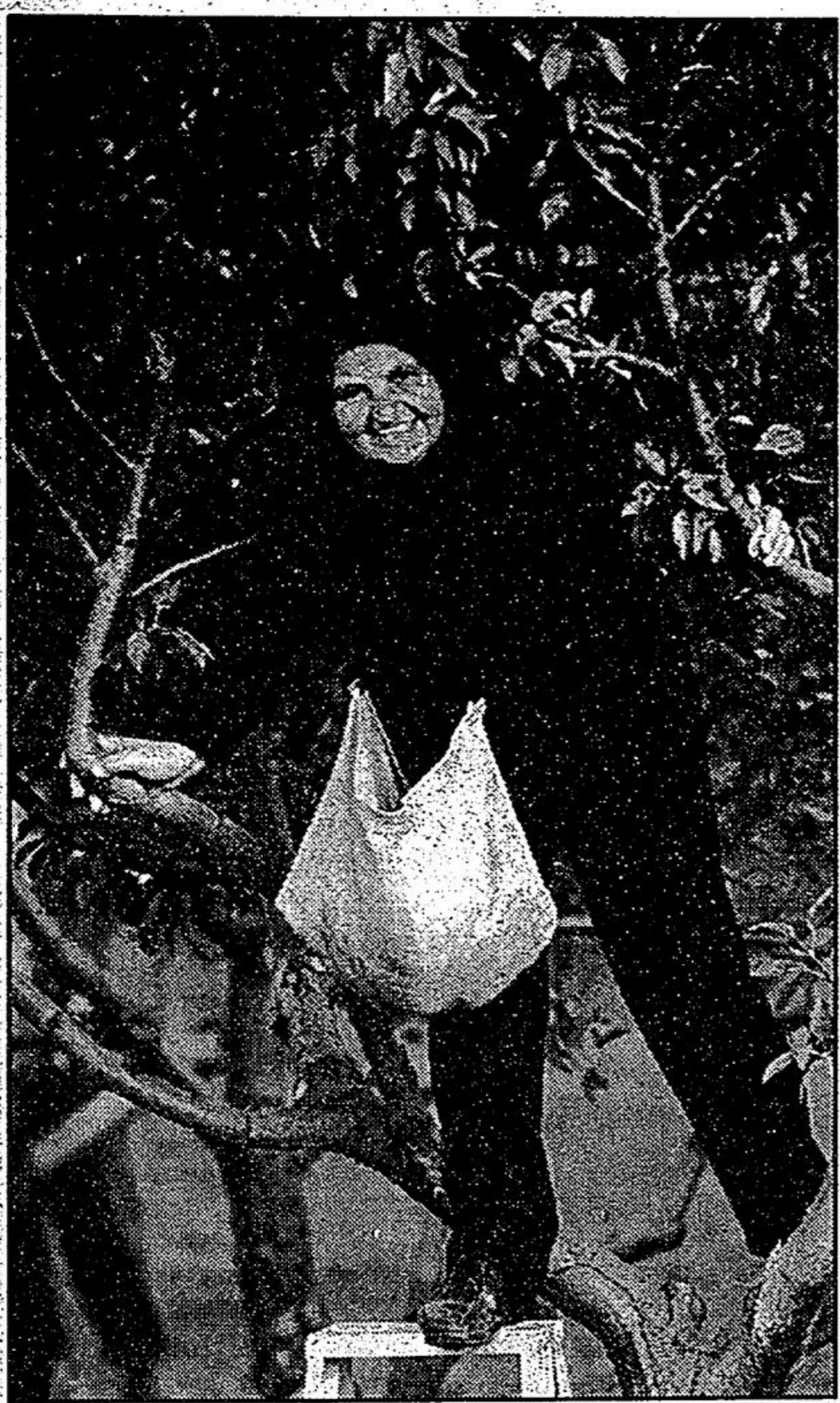
McQuillan is presently the news editor for Blue Line Maga-zine as well as the main editor for Blue Line News Week, a publication that sends out Canadian law enforcement news

on a weekly basis by mail and fax broadcast.

"We are extremely proud of Blair's achievement," said Morley Lymburner, Publisher of Blue Line. "Many years ago we recognized the need to nurture a writer from the ground up so that he would get a firm understanding of the police experience in addition to journalism from Blue Line's terms of reference. Blair's abilities and attitude fit our criteria just right."

McQuillan is continuing his studies in journalism at Durham College in Oshawa.

The award will be presented to McQuillan on Nov. 12 at a presentation dinner hosted by the Southern Ontario News-paper Guild.
